# What is the average income of Syrian refugees?

The average income of Syrian refugees admitted to Canada in 2015 and 2016 was comparable to that of other refugees who spent the same length of time in the country, with annual income levels varying from \$15,000 to \$20,000.

#### Manufacturing sales decline for the third consecutive month

Manufacturing sales declined for the third consecutive month, down 1.3% to \$56.4 billion in December on lower sales of petroleum and coal products (-10.4%).

## The number of adults living with a parent is on the rise

Close to 1.9 million people in Canada, or 9% of the adult population aged 25 to 64, lived with one or more of their parents in 2017. This was more than double the figure in 1995, when 900,000, or 5%, shared a residence with at least one parent.

## Increase in new condominium apartment prices slowing down

According to Statistics Canada's experimental New Condominium Apartment Price Index, which covers Montréal, Ottawa, Toronto, Calgary, Vancouver and Victoria, prices for new condominium apartments increased 9.7% in 2017 and were flat, on average, for the first three quarters of 2018.
