### Higher education pays for graduates from lower-income families

Completing a postsecondary education is linked to a larger increase in earnings among youth from lower-income families than youth from higher-income families.

#### Wine sales sparkle while beer sales remain flat

Wine sales continue to outpace beer sales and now account for almost one-third of all alcoholic beverages sold in Canada. Beer, however, retains top spot in Canada, accounting for nearly 40% of alcohol sales in 2017/2018.

## Over one-third of Canadian Armed Forces veterans report a difficult transition to civilian life

Over one-third of all Canadian Armed Forces veterans reported that they had a very or moderately difficult transition to civilian life. Both female veterans and active female members of the Canadian Armed Forces are more likely to report experiencing symptoms consistent with depression than their male counterparts.
