Insurance premiums on the rise


Canadians paid more year over year for homeowners' home and mortgage insurance (+6.3%) and passenger vehicle insurance premiums (+8.8%) in June. This was partly attributable to the rising cost and frequency of claims associated with weather-related events.

Potato planting picked up this spring

Potato farmers planted 145 906 hectares of potatoes in 2019, up 3.3% from 2018, likely in response to the rising demand for processing potatoes.

Retail sales decline for the first time in four months

Retail sales edged down 0.1% to \$51.5 billion in May, the first decrease in four months. Lower sales at food and beverage stores were the main contributors to the decline.

Breastfeeding most common reason for mothers to share a bed with their infant

One-third of mothers (33%) said that their babies (younger than 1) slept with them or with someone else every day or almost every day. Breastfeeding was the most common reason (39%) given, followed by facilitating the mother's or the child's sleep (29%).
