

## VIUUE OF CHVADINN FIELD CROFS, 1944

## Ottaw, Decomber 12, 1944, 3 p.in.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics

 issues today a bulletin fiving by provinces the first estimate of the farm value of field crop production for 1944 as compared with the values for 1942 and 1943 . The values per unit assigned to each crop represent average prices received by famers up to the end of November and have been determined by the Bureau after consultation with the Provincial Departments of Agriculture. It should be observed that these estimates are subject to revision and that they do not represent cash income received from sales but are gross values of farm production. jeveral of the crops, such as mixed erains, turnips, fodder corn, etc., are almost wholly utilized on the farms on wilich they are grown.
## SUIN:ARY

The cross value of the principal field crops mroduced on Canadian fnrms is estimated at $\$ 1,319$ million for 1914 . This figure constitutes a new hich record being $\$ 185$ million above the 1943 estimate and $\$ 140 \mathrm{million}$ above the previous hich figure of 1942. Better than average crops combined with slightly higher prices in most cases brought about the increased valuc of production. The $19 f_{4}$ figure is almost double the 1939 total value of $\$ 685$ milion. Relatively good crops were harvested this year in all mrovinces but lower prices for potatoes in Prince idward Island and New Brunswick resulted in a reduction in the total value of field crops in those provinces where potatoes are a particularly important factor in: the value of all field crops. Annual comperisons of the value of field crop production since 1932 are as follows:

The value of the wheat crop constitutes more than one-third of the total value of all field crops in 1944. The better then avernge wheat crop hrarested this year together with a slichtly higher average farm price rosulted in a velue of production of $\$ 477$ million for this crop as compared with $\$ 288$ miliion for the 1943 crop. Actually the increase in the value of the wheat crop alone was slightly greater than the increase in the velue of all crops. The value of crops other than wheat do not show any ereat chance as between 1943 and 1944 although the sharp reduction in acreage and production of flaxseed resulted in a reduction in the value of the output of this crop, while, on the other hand, the substantial increase in the production of shelled corn resulted in an increase in the value of this crop from $\$ 6.7 \mathrm{milli}$ on to $\$ 11.6$ million. The 1944 potato crop was substantlally higher than that of 1943 but prices were sharply lower and the total value of the crop declined from $\$ 78$ million to $\$ 60$ miliion. No significant changes took place in the value of other crops as between 1943 and 1944.

Cn a provincial basis the most signiricant chance in the rross value of field crop production occurred in the province of Saskatchowan where the value of the wheat crop is particularly significent. In that pruvince the whoat crop of 1914 tias been Valued at $\overline{j 275}$ million as compared with 2149 million a year ago. st there were no significant clianges in the values of other crops, with the excontion of a reciuction in flaxseed, the total value of crops in Saskatchewn increased from $\$ 344$ million in $19 \% 3$ to $\$ 457$ million in 1944. diberta also onjoyed a substantial increase in the value of her crop. again largely because of the predominant part played by wheat in the total value of all crops. The 1944 figure of almost $\$ 250$ million for Alberta compares with a figure of $\$ 216$ milion for 1943. In ortario the iricreased value of the 1944 crop was more general throupliout the list of farme crops as a result of the better harvests secured in a laree part of that provincc. Prices show very little change as betweon the two years, but the total value of ortario ficld crops increased from 3181 million in 1943 to 3214 million in 1944. A substantial increase of slightly over $\$ 15$ million occurr d in the province of quebec mainly 23 a result of a higher valuation being placed on the 1944 hay crop althoueh better yields of unts aml briley were also a factor. The value of the fianitoba crop was approximately $\$ 5$ million nieher in 1944 than in 19i3. An increase of $\$ 17$ million in the value of the wheat crop was offset to some extent by lower values for oats, barley and flaxseed. Nova Scotia also shows a slifht increaso in the value of croy nroduction particularly in the case of potctoes where a very much larcer crop more than of fset the decrease in price. In Frince Edward Island ard Nova Scotia the sharp reduction in farm prices of potatocs as between 1943 and $1344^{\prime}$ resulted in a net decline ir the value of all ficld crops. A minor reduction is also indicated for British Columbia where lower values for notatoos, Lay and clover tocether with some reduction in the size of the potato crop more than of fset the increasc in the production and value of the 1941 wheat crop.

The total $\forall a l u c$ of all field crops in Canada in 1944 is now estimatec at $31,319,099,000$ as compared with $11,133,734,000$ in 1943.
