VALUE OF CANADIAN FIELD CROPS, 1946
Ottawa, December 12, 1946, 3 p.m. - The Domin on Bureau of Statistics issues today a bulletin civing by provinces the first estimatelol the farm value of field crop production for 1946 as compared with the values for 1944 and 1945. The values per unit assicned to each crop in 1946 represent average prices received by farmers up to the end of November only, and have been determined by the Bureau after consultation with the Provincial Departments of Agriculture. It should be observed that these estimates are subject to revision and that they do not represent cash income received from sales but are gross values of farm production. Several of the crops, such as mixed grains, turnips, fodder corn, etc., are almost wholly utilized on the farms on which they are grown.

## SUMMARY

The fross value of principal field crops produced on canadian farms in 1946 is estimated at $\$ 1,238,645,000$. This is the fifth lighest gross value recorded since the series was commenced in 1908, and has been excceded only in the years 1918, 1919, 1920 and 1944. High prices dur ing the imnediato post-greut var period accounted chiefly for the enhanced value of production recorded in 1918-20, while a relatively high level of production was largely responsible for the greater value figure of 1944. This year's figure is about 9 per cont above the 1945 gross value of production, the increase being lurcely accounted for by a highor level of production in the west this year, although increased prices for some crops have also exerted an upward pressure.

The following table shows a comparison of the gross value of field crop production from 1931 to date. Values for recent years have been revised to include, where applicable, the effects of participation payments for wheat and equalization payments for oats and barley.

Thousand Dollars


The 1346 wheat crop is valued at $\$ 477,487,000$, which is $\$ 24,446,000$ greater than the revised 1945 value of $\$ 353,041,000$. This increase is largely a reflection of the highor production obtainod in the Prairio Provinces this year. There is little difference in the average farm price for wheat for the two years when the retroactive increase of 10 cents in the initial payment for western wheat for the 1945-46 crop year is taken into account. The other principal grain crops, oats, barley, rye, flaxseed and mixed eraine, all show increases of varying degree in the value of production. Due to marked declines in prices, as compared with last yoar, the values of potato and root crops are lover than in 1945 despite increased production this year. The 1946 hay and clover crops were light, and as a rasult the val ue of these crops is down sharply from last year. The estimated value of the alfalfa crop is also below the 1945 level.

The following table shows the values of field crop production for 1946 and 1945, by provinces, together with the changes in value in dollars and in percentages:

Compared on a provincial basis the greatest change in the gross value of field crop production has occurred in Alberta, where the total increase in the value of the 1946 crop amounts to $\$ 92,046,000$, representing an increase of 49 per cent from the 1945 values. Substantial increases in value from last year's levels were also recorded by the other western provinces, with the estimated gains for Manitoba, Saskatchewan and British Columbia amounting to 20,7 and 14 per cent respectively. The higher value in the western provinces must be attributed chiefly to increased production, as prices for most of their principal field crops have varied but little from 1945 levels.

Passing eastward, a very different situation prevails. In Ontario the 1946 value of field crop production is practically unchanged from last year, having dropped a fraction of one per cent. Thile significant declines are registered in this province for the values of wheat, hay and clover and alfalfa production, these have been largely offset by increased values for coarse grains, and beans and peas. queboc and the Maritimes experienced generally unfavourable growing conditions for the principal grain and hay crops this year and reduction in value from last year's levels is substantial in all four provinces. While potato production in these provinces was up considerably over last year, sharply reduced prices have more than offset the added production.

The sugar beet prices shown for 1946 indicate initial paynents only, and upward revisions will be required in the value of this crop in each of the four provinces concerned as soon as the extent of the final payments is known.

The total value of all field crops in Canada in 1946 is now estimated at $\$ 1,238,645,000$ as compared with $\$ 1,135,264,000$ in 1945 . The 1946 total is made up of the following items, with the 1945 values within brackets: Wheat $\$ 477,487,000$ $(\$ 353,041,000)$; oats $\$ 210,610,000(\$ 203,113,000)$; barley $\$ 106,034,000(\$ 105,452,000)$; rye $\$ 13,288,000(\$ 8,680,000)$; peas $\$ 6,638,000(\$ 3,863,000)$; beans $\$ 4,871,000(\mathrm{~m}, 456,000$ buckwheat $\$ 4,094,000(\$ 4,544,000)$; mixed grains $\$ 36,457,000(\$ 30,353,000)$; fluxseed $\$ 22,206,000(\$ 19,006,000)$; corn shelled $\$ 11,157,000(\$ 10,774,000)$; potatoes $\$ 75,252,000$ $(\$ 81,168,000)$; turnips, etc. $\$ 20,068,000(\$ 22,246,000)$; hay and clover $\$ 176,597,000$ $(\$ 213,769,000)$; alfalfa $\$ 41,358,000(\$ 48,130,000)$; fodder corn $\$ 16,667,000(\$ 15,128,000)$; grain hay $\$ 10,092,000(\$ 5,915,000)$; sugar beets $\$ 5,769,000$ initial payment $(\$ 6,566,000)$.

By provinces in order of magnitude, the total values of 1946 crops are as follows, with the 1945 figures within brackets: Saskatchewen $\$ 342,109,000(\$ 319,559,000)$; Alberta $\$ 279,671,000(\$ 187,625,000)$; Ontario $\$ 230,626,000(\$ 231,079,000)$; Manitoba $\$ 163,365,000(\$ 136,280,000)$; Quebec $\$ 132,450,000(\$ 158,190,000)$; British Columbia \$28,057,000 ( $\$ 24,686,000$ ); New Brunswick $\$ 28,006,000(\$ 37,251,000)$; Nova Scotia, $\$ 19,017,000(\$ 21,519,000)$; Prince Edward Island $\$ 15,344,000(\$ 18,975,000)$.

For the three Prairie provinces the total value of the five principal erain crops in 1946 is estimated as follows, with the 1945 values within brackets: Wheat $\$ 452,760,000(\$ 26,720,000)$; oats $\$ 138,060,000(\$ 136,535,000)$; barley $\$ 94,670,000$ $(\$ 94,805,000)$; rye $\$ 11,206,000(\$ 7,278,000)$; flaxseed $\$ 21,673,000(\$ 18,404,000)$. The total value of the five crops for the three provinces amounts to $\$ 718,369,000$ in 1946 as compared with $\$ 583,742,000$ in 1945.

The average prices received by farmers for the 1946 crops up to the end of November are estimated as follows, with the prices of 1945 crops within brackets: Cents per bushel - Wheat 114 (115); oats 53 (53); barley 66 (67); rye 192 (147); peas 296 (283); beans 311 (267); buckwheat 86 (87); mixed gral ns 66 (65); flaxseed 290 (250); corn, shelled 106 (104). Cents per cwt. - Potatoes 157 (226); turnips, etc. 73 (87). Dollars per ton - Hay and clover 12.02 (12.06); alfalfa 12.91 (12.40); fodder corn 4.21 (4.18); grain hay $6.25(6.71)$; sugar beets 8.03 initial payment (10.60).
