Ottawa, August 14, 1925. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics  
reports the receipt of a cablegram from the Indian Director of Statistics  
at Calcutta stating that the final estimate of the production of wheat in  
India for the season 1924-25 is 324,651,000 bushels from 31,773,000 acres,  
as compared with 364,143,000 bushels from 31,173,000 acres, the final  
estimate for 1923-24, and with 321,257,000 bushels from 28,515,000 acres,  
the annual averages for the five years ended 1922. The yield now reported  
viz. 324,651,000 bushels is 10 p.c. less than that of 1923-24 and 2 p.c.  
less than the five-year average. The acreage of 31,773,000 acres is 2 p.c.  
more than the finally reported area for 1923-24, and 11 p.c. more than the  
five-year average.
