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## LIVE STOCK SURVEY - DECEMIBER 1, 1944

## HOGS

Uttawa, Februnry 26, 1945.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today ${ }^{1}$ report on the December survey of live stock and poultry dealing with the numbers of hogs on farms, the 1944 fall pie crop, and numbers of sows to farrow in the spring of 1945. This report is based on information obtained from farmers and is prepared in co-operation with the nrevincial derartments of agriculture.

## Stucwiy

Ihniers of hogs on femm do vecomber 1 , 1944 show a substantial decline from the record hich fieure of a yeur $a_{i} 0$. The total of $7,646,800$ head represents a aecline of 19.3 per cent and a return to approximately the same level as at Decomber 1 , 1242. The decline was comon to all provinces except ontario and Nova Scotia where very iittle chance is indicated. The provinces of Lanitoba and Saskatchewan, where production increased most rapidiy in recent years, show the sharpest declinos. A continuation of the contraction in hog production is indicated in an estinated reduction of 17.3 per cent in sows bred to farrow in the first six months of 1945. The hogs resulting from these farrowings together with those on hand at December 1 , will constitute the marketincs of 1945. Present indications are, therefore, that marketings in 1945 will be from 15 to 20 per cent below those of $19 \% 4$.
