LIVE STOCK SURVEY - DECEMBER 1, 1944

HOGS

Ottawa, February 26, 1945.— The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues teday a report on the December survey of live stock and poultry dealing with the numbers of hogs on farms, the 1944 fall pig crop, and numbers of sows to farrow in the spring of 1945. This report is based on information obtained from farmers and is prepared in co-operation with the provincial departments of agriculture.

SULLIARY

Numbers of hegs on forms at December 1, 1944 show a substantial decline from the record high figure of a year a.o. The total of 7,646,800 head represents a decline of 19.3 per cent and a return to approximately the same level as at December 1, 1942. The decline was common to all provinces except Ontario and Nova Scotia where very little change is indicated. The provinces of Manitoba and Saskatchewan, where production increased most rapidly in recent years, show the sharpest declines. A continuation of the contraction in hog production is indicated in an estimated reduction of 17.3 per cent in sows bred to farrow in the first six months of 1945. The hogs resulting from these farrowings together with those on hand at December 1, will constitute the marketings of 1945. Present indications are, therefore, that marketings in 1945 will be from 15 to 20 per cent below those of 1944.
