LIVE STOCK SURVEY - DECEMBER 1, 1948

Ottawa, April 2, 1949: The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today the second report on the December Live Stock Survey. The report covers estimates of the numbers of cattle, sheep and horses on farms in Canada at December 1, 1948. A report released on March 12 dealt with swine estimates. These reports are based on compilations from schedules completed by farmers in December, 1948 and are prepared in cooperation with the Provincial Departments of Agriculture.

CATTLE

There were 8,251,000 cattle on farms in Canada at December 1, 1948. This estimate indicates a decline of 7.7 per cent from the 8,944,000 total at December 1, 1947. Reductions occurred in all provinces except Prince Edward Island and British Columbia. The total number of milk cows declined only 3.5 per cent. Favourable prices resulted in greater liquidation of other classes of cattle and calves than of milk cows.

SHEEP AND LAMBS

The total of 1,322,000 sheep and lambs on farms in Canada at December 1, 1948 represents a 16.7 per cent reduction from 1,587,000 at December 1, 1947. Decreases were most marked in Quebec and Manitoba. Lambs were marketed earlier than in 1947 and a smaller proportion of the spring lamb crop was carried over. The reduction in breeding stock was less than that shown in the accompanying tables for total numbers. Sheep over one year old declined about 13 per cent from the number on farms at December 1, 1947.

HORSES

Total horses on farms at December 1, 1948 were estimated at 1,842,000, a decline of almost 7 per cent from the total at the same date in 1947. Decreases occurred in all provinces but were greater in Saskatchewan, Alberta and Ontario than in other provinces.
