ADVANCE REPORT ON THE FUR FARMS OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND,

NOVA SCOTIA AND NEW BRUNSWICK, 1939.

Issued herewith is an advance report on the fur farming industry of Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick. A similar statement for Ontario and the Western Provinces was published earlier in the month,

The number of fur farms in operation in the three provinces in 1939 was 2,572, a reduction from the preceding year of 425. By provinces the numbers of farms are as follows; with figures for 1938 in brackets: Prince Edward Island, 912 (1,024); Nova Scotia, 915, (1,032); and New Brunswick, 745 (941). The value of property in the three provinces combined was \$2,172,863, compared with \$2,953,861 in 1938.

Fur-bearing animals born on the farms totalled 81,926, compared with 93,129 in 1938. The principal kinds are silver foxes - 65,959, and minks - 14,643. Each of the provinces shows a decrease from 1938 in the number of silver foxes born and an increase in the number of minks. The decrease in the number of silver foxes born in the three provinces was 15,081, while the increase in the number of minks was 3,540.

The revenue derived by the industry from the sale of live fur-bearing animals was \$50,011, and of pelts, \$1,371,786, - a total of \$1,421,797, compared with \$1,799,046 in 1938. By provinces, the totals are as follows, with figures for 1938 in brackets: Prince Edward Island, \$572,435 (\$721,764); Nova Scotia, \$361,959 (\$445,649); and New Brunswick, \$487,403 (\$631,633).

At the end of the year 1939 the number of fur-bearing animals of all kinds retained on the farms of the three provinces was 34,970 and the value \$912,547, compared with 48,586 and value of \$1,486,227 in the preceding year. The principal kinds are silver foxes, 27,884, value \$787,852, and minks 6,410, value \$91,300. The new types of foxes - platinum and white-face - are also represented, with a total of 62, valued at \$12,200.
