


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ESTIMATED VALUE OF MANUFACTURERS' SHIPMENTS,  
SECOND QUARTER 1954

The basis trend data used in making the estimates included in this report are the values of monthly sales, or shipments, as reported by a sample of manufacturing establishments. In industries where long-term contracts involve the receipt of progress payments, all such payments are treated as sales. In addition, a limited number of industries are incorporated by other means. The trend established for each industry is applied to the gross value of shipments universe for the industry available from the Annual Census of Industry Survey.

The estimates are shown by the 17 major industrial groups, and not by individual industries. They are shown, also, by economic use groupings, into which individual industries have been assigned in total. In both presentations, data for 1952 and 1953 are included to provide a measure of change.

In the current release, estimates for the four quarters, 1953, and for the first two quarters, 1954, have been adjusted to 1953 levels established by a preliminary tabulation of the Annual Census of Industry Survey for 1953. The revised totals show that the value of manufacturers shipments for the first six months of 1954 totalled \$8,607,736,000.
