THE PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS INDUSTRY, 1945

The prepared stock and poultry feeds industry is an important factor in the agricultural development of the Dominion, in so far as it relates to animal husbandry and poultry raising. In addition to the feed grown by farmers themselves, when crop conditions are favourable, large quantities of scientifically blended feeds are produced annually by manufacturers of prepared stock and poultry feeds. For the year 1945 the output of this industry was valued at \$70,250,739 requiring the labour of 3,486 persons whose remuneration amounted to \$5,563,756. The value of the grain and other materials used totalled \$57,914,289. In 1945 there were 222 establishments reporting in this industry, distributed by provinces as follows: Prince Edward Island, 2; Nova Scotia, 2; New Brunswick, 7; Quebec, 53; Ontario, 86; Manitoba, 13; Saskatchewan, 8; Alberta, 22 and British Columbia, 29.

The feeds and other products shown in Table 2, which presents in detail the production in the stock and poultry feeds industry, were reported by firms whose main business consists of the manufacture of prepared stock and poultry feeds, by firms who are primarily dealers in grains and feeds, but who produce considerable quantities of mixed feeds, and by large manufacturers of other commodities who have important production of feeds and who are now co-operating by reporting such operations separately under the stock and poultry feeds industry. The names of firms submitting reports in this industry are listed in the final pages of this report.

The increase in the number of establishments reporting in the stock and poultry feeds industry proper is due to our efforts of having as many firms as possible reporting under other industrial classifications make separate reports for their feed production. This accounts in large measure for the increased production of the industry in 1944. Whereas in 1943 the industry proper accounted for 69 per cent of the total production of prepared stock and poultry feeds, in 1944 the percentage rose to 92.

However, there are still large quantities of stock and poultry feeds which are manufactured by firms reporting under other industrial classifications, principally "flour and feed mills" and by dealers in grains and feeds not reporting under the stock and poultry feeds industry proper. Therefore, in order to obtain comprehensive statistics, a supplementary production survey of such producers has been made annually since 1939. In this connection, use has been made of the fact that all firms manufacturing mixed feeds must register their formulae with the Plant Products Division of the Department of Agriculture, and the Bureau has endeavoured to obtain reports from all licensed firms.

Tables 3 and 3(a) give for the years 1942 and 1943 detailed production statistics in the stock and poultry feeds industry proper as well as details of the production in all other industries, as secured from the supplementary survey referred to above. Similar information for 1944 and 1945 is shown in Tables 4 and 4(a) for Canada and provinces. The total production of prepared stock and poultry feeds in 1945 totalled 1,312,951 tons. Of this amount 1,165,173 tons were reported in the stock and poultry feeds industry and 147,778 tons by other manufacturing industries and retail stores mixing feeds. Corresponding figures for 1944 were 1,160,358, 1,068,719 and 91,639, respectively. Compared with the previous year there was an increase of 152,593 tons in the total production from all sources.

It should be noted that the detailed statistics relating to materials used, employment, etc., published in this report refer ONLY to the firms reporting under the "Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds Industry".
