

THE PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS INDUSTRY, 1947

The prepared stock and poultry feeds industry is an important factor in the agricultural development of the Dominion, in so far as it relates to animal husbandry and poultry raising. In addition to the feed grown by farmers themselves, when crop conditions are favourable, large quantities of scientifically blended feeds are produced annually by manufacturers of prepared stock and poultry feeds. For the year 1947 the output of this industry was valued at \$120,553,040 requiring the labour of 4,436 persons whose remuneration amounted to \$7,901,202. The value of the grain and other materials used totalled \$100,384,042. In 1947 there were 285 establishments reporting in this industry, distributed by provinces as follows: Prince Edward Island 3, Nova Scotia 3, New Brunswick 7, Quebec 74, Ontario 104, Manitoba 21, Saskatchewan 13, Alberta 28 and British Columbia 32.

The feeds and other products shown in Table 2, which presents in detail the production in the stock and poultry feeds industry, were reported by firms whose main business consists of the manufacture of prepared stock and poultry feeds, by firms who are primarily dealers in grains and feeds, but who produce considerable quantities of mixed feeds, and by large manufacturers of other commodities who have important production of feeds and who are now co-operating by reporting such operations separately under the stock and poultry feeds industry. The names of firms submitting reports in this industry are listed in the final pages of this report.

The increase in the number of establishments reporting in the stock and poultry feeds industry proper is due to efforts made to have as many firms as possible reporting under other industrial classifications make separate reports for their feeds production. This accounts in large measure for the increased production of the industry since 1944. Whereas in 1943 the industry proper accounted for 69 per cent of the total production of prepared stock and poultry feeds, in 1947 the percentage rose to 90.

However, there are still large quantities of stock and poultry feeds which are manufactured by firms reporting under other industrial classifications, principally "flour and feed mills" and by dealers in grains and feeds not reporting under the stock and poultry feeds industry proper. Therefore, in order to obtain comprehensive statistics, a supplementary production survey of such producers has been made annually since 1939. In this connection, use has been made of the fact that all firms manufacturing mixed feeds must register their formulae with the Plant Products Division of the Department of Agriculture, and the Bureau has endeavoured to obtain reports from all licensed firms.

Table 2 gives comparative production figures of the industry proper, for Canada as a whole, 1946 and 1947. Table 3 gives in detail, the total production of feeds in Canada, for the years 1941 to 1946 in the stock and poultry feeds industry proper, as well as in all other industries (as secured from the supplementary survey referred to above). Table 4 gives similar figures for 1947, for Canada and the provinces. The total production of prepared stock and poultry feeds in 1947 totalled 1,839,771 tons. Of this amount 1,665,000 tons were reported in the stock and poultry feeds industry and 174,771 tons by other manufacturing industries and retail stores mixing feeds. Compared with the previous year there was an increase 280,959 tons in the total production from all sources.

It should be noted that the detailed statistics relating to employment, salaries and wages, etc., published in this report refer ONLY to the firms reporting under the "Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds Industry", as listed on pages 12 to 18.


