

# THE PREPARED STOCK AND POULTRY FEEDS INDUSTRY

## 1952

The prepared stock and poultry feeds industry is an important factor in the agricultural development of the Dominion, in so far as it relates to animal husbandry and poultry raising. In addition to the feed grown by farmers themselves when crop conditions are favourable, large quantities of scientifically blended feeds are produced annually by manufacturers of prepared stock and poultry feeds. For the year 1952 the output of this industry was valued at \$181,080,732 requiring the labour of 5,938 persons whose remunerations amounted to \$13,392,352. The value of the grain and other materials used totalled \$148,801,788. In 1952 there were 671 establishments reporting in this industry, distributed by provinces as follows: Prince Edward Island 10, Nova Scotia 10, New Brunswick 13, Quebec 208, Ontario 289, Manitoba 33, Saskatchewan 12, Alberta 51, and British Columbia 45.

In 1944, there was a large increase in the number of firms in the Industry proper. Some firms, classified in other industries, were required to make separate reports covering their feed manufacturing activities only, and these returns were then incorporated in the Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds group. This accounts in large measure for the increased production of that year. Again in 1950 and each following year there were further increases in the number of firms reporting due to the co-operation of the Licensing Section of the Plant Products Division of the Department of Agriculture. In addition, there are quantities of Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds manufactured by firms reporting under other industrial classifications such as The Flour and Feed Milling Industry. This additional production has been assembled separately in Table 5.

The feeds and other products shown in Table 2, which presents in detail the production in the stock and poultry feeds industry, were reported by firms whose main business consists of the manufacture of complete feeds, by firms who are primarily dealers in grains and feeds but who produce considerable quantities of mixed feeds, and by large manufacturers in the other industrial classifications who have substantial feed departments and who are now co-operating by reporting such operations separately under the stock and poultry feeds industry. The names of firms submitting reports in this industry are listed in the final pages of this report.

Previous to 1950 the selling value of custom chopped grains was included in the total selling value of products. It was felt that the resulting production figure could be improved and in 1950 a new procedure was adopted wherein the custom chopping was collected separately. Only the amount received for chopping and grinding was required, and this amount was added to the value of any other products made by the reporting firm. Table 3 shows the quantity and kind of grain chopped and the amount received for this work.

Table 4 gives in detail the total production of feeds in Canada for the years 1946 to 1951 in the stock and poultry feeds industry proper as well as in all other industries. Table 5 gives similar figures for 1952 for Canada and the provinces. The total production of prepared stock and poultry feeds in 1952 totalled 1,977,722 tons. Of this amount 1,768,299 tons were reported in the stock and poultry feeds industry and 209,423 tons by other manufacturing industries. Compared with the previous year there was an increase of 100,079 tons in the total production from all sources.

It should be noted that the detailed statistics relating to employment, salaries and wages etc., published in this report refer only to the firms reporting under the "Prepared Stock and Poultry Feeds Industry", as listed on pages 12-15.
