



FOREWORD

The tables which follow present statistics for establishments engaged in processing fish at the secondary industrial level. These establishments constitute an integral part of the Bureau's industrial statistics of the Foods and Beverages Group. Some fishermen also process the fish they land to a certain degree, but their operations are not included here. Consequently the tabular matter of this bulletin will differ from that published in "Fisheries Statistics of Canada, 1954". Furthermore the inland areas (Ontario, Prairie Provinces, Yukon and Northwest Territories) are not at present included in the Census of Industry Survey although some fish processing is done there.


