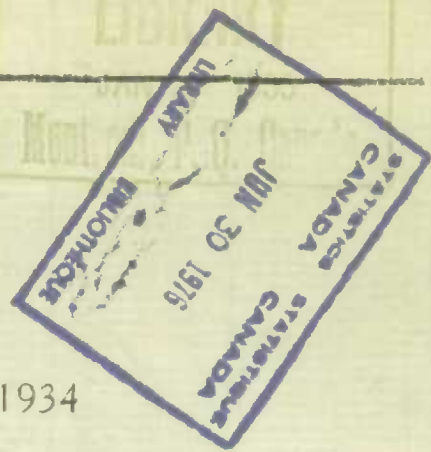

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## COLD STORAGE REPORTS

In presenting a summary on cold storage reports for 1934 it should be understood that the figures given herein are principally revised data and may differ to some extent from the figures shown in the final monthly reports. In most cases the holdings are greater than those that appeared in previous statements. Where reductions have been made, this fact is indicated by the symbol set opposite the item concerned. Data from individual firms that were received too late to appear in the monthly reports are included in this statement. The holdings of all new firms that were added to the list since March 1, 1934 are shown for the months in which they reported. With a few exceptions, the returns from these firms only cover the period subsequent to the date on which they were added to the list. The statement below shows the number of firms outstanding in the monthly report and the number outstanding in the annual summary, also the number added since March 1, which did not report to the Bureau for the months indicated after being listed.

It will be noticed that the numbers of outstanding firms were considerably higher from August to December. This is largely due to the closing of country creameries, many of which have little or no stock on hand.

While variations between the monthly reports and the annual summary are due largely to the failure on the part of reporting firms to file their returns in time, or to the addition of new firms to the mailing list, minor changes were also necessary, due to errors in the individual statements which were later corrected by the firms. The number of these errors is decreasing as those reporting cold storage stocks become more familiar with the classifications used and what should or should not be included in their returns.

Another fact that should be remembered in analyzing these data is that the firms which reported for one particular month may not have reported for some other month; hence the total holdings cannot always be regarded as comparable data. When it is desired to compare the stocks as shown in the current monthly reports with the holdings reported in the preceding month of the same year, reference should be made to that part of the statement which shows the holdings based on limited lists. The figures therein include only those amounts which were reported by firms that filed statements for both months. Similarly when comparisons are to be made between a given month in 1934 and the same month in 1933 or previous years, it is necessary to add to the figures given for the former period or subtract from the latter, the approximate holdings of firms that were added to the list within the year. This refers particularly to creamery butter. In 1933, 135 creameries with mechanical refrigeration were listed and asked to report their stocks. In 1934 those with ice storages were also included. 341 creameries with mechanical refrigeration and other cooling devices and 22 cold storage plants reporting butter were added during the period covered by this report. The data given in the table below will make it possible to compare more accurately the creamery butter holdings for 1933 and 1934 with the same months in the previous year.

During 1934 some changes were made in the classification of pork, and of fish. In the case of pork the items were increased in number and classified in conformance with accepted trade terms; the object being to make the data more valuable for commercial purposes. In regard to fish, three varieties, finnan haddie, pickerel and tulibee, were added that had not been shown previously, and herring was grouped into two classes, sea herring and lake herring. The revisions with respect to these products were made on the recommendation of cold storage firms and fish dealers. The changes in respect to pork went into effect on January 1, and the changes in regard to fish appeared in the issue of April 1. Since the new classifications include certain items not recorded in 1933, complete comparisons could not be made with the same month of the previous year.

Commencing with the report for January 1935, creamery butter has been grouped into two parts, i.e., butter reported by cold storage plants, and butter reported by creameries. This makes it possible to determine how much butter is being held by the producers in their own establishments, and to compare the holdings of cold storage plants apart from creamery holdings. Since these data are also available for 1933, monthly comparisons with last year will appear in all statements.

The complete monthly report of cold storage holdings was published on January 10, 1935, two days earlier than usual. This obviates the necessity of issuing preliminary totals for Canada on that date and avoids the discrepancies which used to occur between the preliminary and final figures by the addition of late reports.

It has been felt for some time that the fruit situation has not received sufficient attention from a cold storage standpoint. With the commencement of the fruit season as at June 1, firms were asked to report small fruits of domestic origin held under refrigeration. These are classified in order of importance and are reported as fresh and frozen. With the publication of the report for January 1935, apples and small fruits are being reported by provinces, and by principal cities from which three or more returns have been received. All fruit data with complete comparisons are now being shown on the final page of the monthly report, a change which will make the statement more acceptable to those who have occasion to use these statistics.

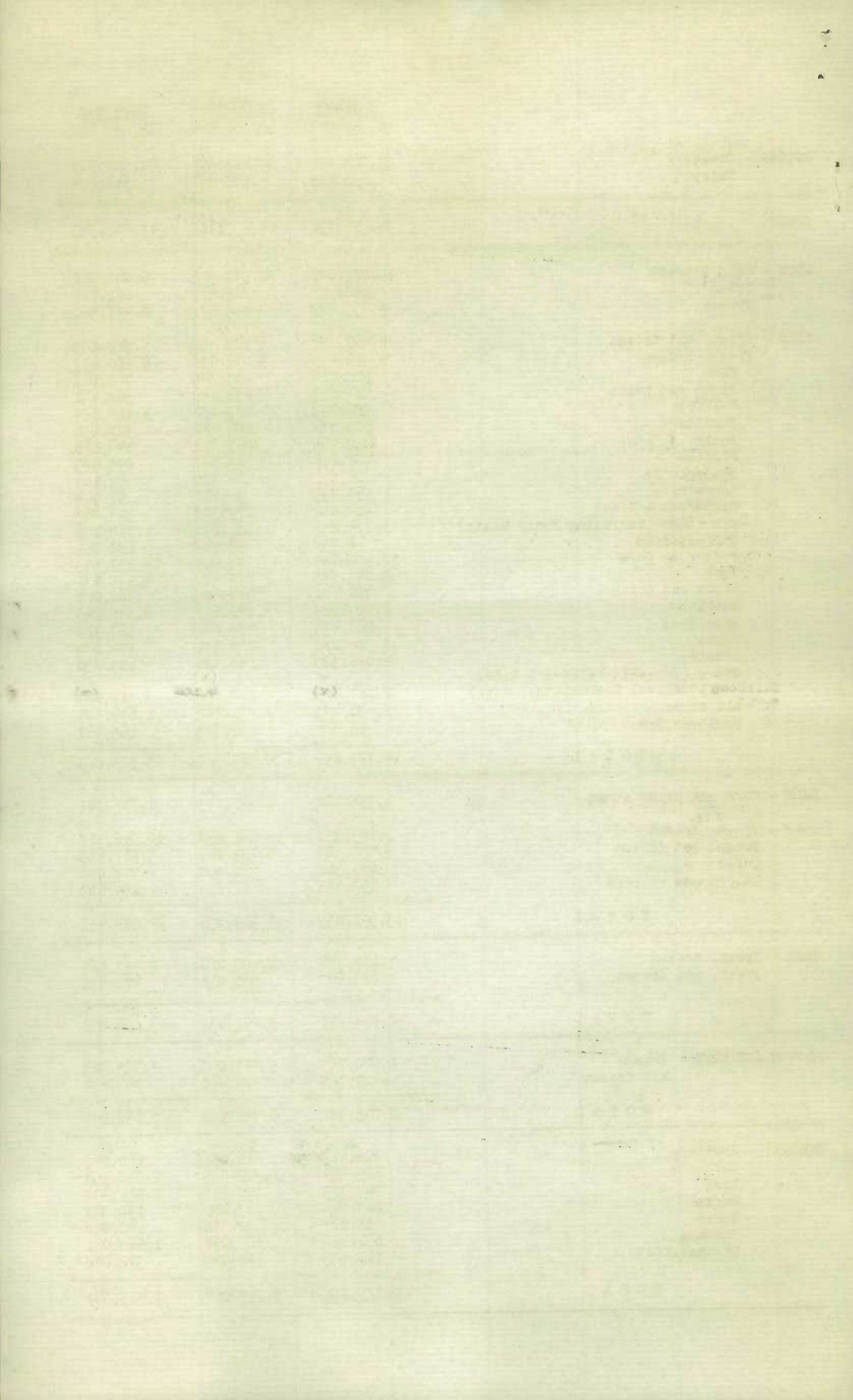
