



SUMMARY OF STORAGE REPORTS, 1942

The summary for 1942 gives final data on stocks of food commodities in dairy factories and in cold storage and other wholesale warehouses, including meat packing plants.

Grateful thanks are extended to the members of the staffs of reporting firms who completed the many schedules and to all the Government officials, Provincial and Dominion, who have assisted in the collection and compilation of much of the data. The Dominion Department of Agriculture, Marketing Service, through the Fruit Inspectors, reported the stocks of fresh fruits and vegetables; the Dairy Commissioners and Dairy Superintendents of six of the provinces, the Quebec Bureau of Statistics, the Statistics Branch of the Ontario Department of Agriculture and the Agricultural Statistician of the Manitoba Department of Agriculture collected the data on stocks of butter and cheese in the dairy factories of their respective provinces, and many of these officials, resident in nine of the principal cities, including the Dairy Produce Grader of the Dominion Department of Agriculture in Vancouver, also collected figures of stocks of butter, cheese and eggs for the nine cities' advance statement.

Prior to 1924 a one page summary as at the first of the month for all Canada was published on the 15th of each month and a detailed report was issued on the 25th of each month. Since that time more detail has been introduced and an endeavour made to release the information closer to the reported date, until now the following reports are published monthly: (1) Advance Preliminary Statement, Stocks of Butter, Cheese and Eggs in the principal Cities of Canada (known generally as the Nine Cities' Report). This is issued on the second business day of each month. (2) Stocks of Dairy and Poultry Products, (3) Cold Storage Holdings of Meat and Lard, (4) Storage Holdings of Fish and (5) Stocks of Canadian Fruits and Vegetables. The last four reports are issued on the 10th of each month and show preliminary data as at the opening of business on the first of the current month, revised figures for the first of the previous month and final holdings for the previous year at the same date.

In July 1940 "Wholesale Stocks of Food Commodities in Canada in Cold and Common Storage, 1920-1939" was published and copies are still available. They may be obtained from the Distribution Division, Administration Branch, Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Owing to the disturbance in the distribution of butter towards the end of 1942 and the inauguration of butter rationing, the Food Administration of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board requested us to obtain weekly data on stocks of creamery butter in the nine cities, which stocks were already being obtained monthly. These weekly data were first obtained for December 12.

Our inspector visited 1107 establishments during the calendar year 1942. Most of these inspections were in dairy factories, but many inspections were also made in cold storages, meat packing plants and abattoirs, wholesale warehouses of grocers, butchers, fish, fruit and produce firms and in condenseries and jam manufacturing plants. Visits were also made to Government officials and special investigations conducted.


