SUMMARY OF STORAGE REPORTS 1943

The data herein are final figures for stocks of food commodities, as at the opening of business on the first of each month in 1943, in cold storage and other wholesale warehouses, including meat plants and dairy factories, throughout Canada.

Preliminary and revised data were published each month in the following reports: (a) "Advance Preliminary Statement, Stocks of Butter, Cheese and Eggs in the Principal Cities of Canada", generally known as the Nine Cities' Report, and published on the second business day of each month, (b) "Stocks of Dairy and Poultry Products," (c) "Cold Storage Holdings of Meat and Lard", (d) "Cold Storage Holdings of Fish", and (e) "Stocks of Canadian Fruits and Vegetables"; these last four being issued on the 10th of each month.

Casein stocks in the hands of users is a new classification published in 1943 for the first time, being obtained for the Dairy Products Board owing to its greater demand in war time.

The increased production of farm products was reflected in the data of some of the stocks on hand, which, in many commodities, were large. Creamery butter stocks on October 1, the peak date, were the highest ever recorded, as were the holdings of frozen eggs on September 1. Stocks of cheese on the peak date, October 1, were lower than the holdings for the last six months of last year, but were the highest for any year prior to 1942. The quantities of shell eggs on hand were not as large as in recent years, despite increased egg production, owing to the intensified manufacture of egg powder for overseas shipment. Stocks of dressed poultry were not as high as in 1942 but were higher than the peak months of 1941 and as high as the highest stocks in 1940. Holdings of pork, although higher than pre-war stocks, were not quite as high as in recent years, while a similar situation obtained for beef; nevertheless, storage space for meats was difficult to obtain at the end of the year.

The inauguration of butter rationing at the end of 1942 during a period of scarcity of this product made a more frequent compilation of stocks in nine of the principal cities desirable for the Dairy Products Administrator of the Wartime Prices and Trade Board, until the scarcity crisis had passed. Consequently weekly data on stocks of creamery butter were obtained from firms in those cities until the end of June, when production had reached its peak. These reports were for the use of the Administrator and were, therefore, not published.

During the year visits were made to 1032 establishments by our inspector, who checked the records and, in most places, the actual stocks of some commodities. In addition government officials were visited and some special investigations were made for the Wartime Prices and Trade Board in connection with the butter subsidy.

Without the work of hundreds of clerks in the offices of firms throughout the Dominion it would be impossible to provide the data shown in the summary and in our monthly storage reports. That work was done under stress of increased reporting to other Government departments and we are grateful. Thanks are also tendered to all the Provincial and Dominion Government officials who were such a great help in many ways in obtaining data throughout the year.




