

SUMMARY OF STORAGE REPORTS 1944

As may be seen in a scrutiny of the data in this summary large stocks of food commodities were held in storage during the storage seasons for the various foods. The storage space was in cold storage and other warehouses and in dairy factories in all the provinces of Canada.

In the 1943 summary it was stated that storage space for meats was difficult to obtain at the end of the year. This demand for space became acute during the early part of 1944. There was heavy slaughtering of meat animals at that time and this, together with an insufficiency of refrigerated ocean bottoms and of refrigerated railway cars, the latter due to increased transportation demand, contributed to the large accumulations. The lowered meat stocks on June 1 and thereafter, as shown on pages 4 to 7 herein, indicated large withdrawals during May and the three subsequent months, which relieved the space situation considerably, allowing for space for the seasonal increases in stocks of butter, cheese and eggs. Lard stocks were never so high; it will be noticed on page 5 that they reached almost to 21.5 million pounds but exports relieved the situation thereafter. For the first time, stocks of edible tallow were obtained in 1944. The data are given on pages 6 and 7. Stocks of frozen fish were higher in each month than the 1943 holdings.

In the early part of the year stocks of butter in storage and in transit were higher than in 1943. The usual seasonal increases occurred from May 1 to October 1, as may be seen on pages 2 and 3, but, as compared with the 1943 holdings, the stocks steadily declined. Cheese holdings on the other hand increased monthly from April 1, 1944 as compared with the 1943 stocks. The increase in stocks of shell and frozen eggs during the year was remarkable. In the peak month the holdings of shell eggs were more than three times the quantity held in the peak month of 1943, while frozen eggs were well over twice the 1943 stocks in the respective peak months. Dressed poultry holdings throughout the year were considerably in excess of those of 1943.

The classifications for fruit, frozen and in preservatives, were increased, and imported fruits were added. A separation of fruits and vegetables into "Consumer packages" and "For reprocessing" was also made this year.

All the data were published monthly as preliminary and revised figures in the following reports: (a) "Advance Preliminary Statement, Stocks of Butter, Cheese and Eggs in the Principal Cities of Canada", published on the second business day of each month; (b) "Stocks of Dairy and Poultry Products", (c) "Cold Storage Holdings of Meat and Lard", (d) "Cold Storage Holdings of Fish" and (e) "Stocks of Fruit and Vegetables", all issued on the 10th of the month.

The figures given herein are final. This summary and the monthly reports were made possible through the co-operation of the staffs of firms and of Dominion and Provincial officials throughout the country. Thanks for the work done by them are extended to all.

Weekly figures on stocks of creamery butter in nine of the principal cities in Canada were obtained for the Wartime Prices and Trade Board up to the end of June and began again on October 13. These data, however, were not published.

Inspections were, as usual, made during the year, as were visits to government officials.


