

SUMMARY OF COLD STORAGE REPORTS -- 1947

The summary for 1947 sets out the revised data on stocks of food commodities held in dairy factories, cold storage warehouses and other wholesale establishments, including meat packing plants. Preliminary and current revisions of data on these stocks were published in monthly reports throughout the year. Graphical presentation of the data is included in a special section following the summary tables.

Creamery butter stocks were higher on the first of each month in 1947 than in 1946 with the exception of September 1. The low point of the year was May 1, when the stocks were 11,248,810 pounds while the high point of the year was October 1, with stocks of 73,374,007 pounds, this being the highest since 1943. During 1947 weekly butter stock figures which had previously been obtained seasonally, under wartime regulations, were released to the public. The first press release in this series being issued on May 9. These data are included in this report.

Cheese holdings were lower than in 1946 for the first three months of the year, increased very slightly on April 1 but from May 1 to August 1 they were again lower. There was a marked increase at September 1 after which there was the usual seasonal decrease but the stocks were considerably greater than in the previous year. The average stocks of Evaporated Whole Milk in the hands of manufacturers were greater from February to June than in 1946, decreases however being evident on January 1 and also for the last six months of the year.

Stocks of shell eggs were very much higher from May 1 to the end of the year than in 1946, with the peak of 29,266,638 dozens on hand at August 1. Frozen eggs in storage increased steadily over 1946 stocks after April 1, the peak being September 1, when the stocks were 16,462,874 pounds. Stocks of dressed poultry were decidedly higher throughout 1947 than in the previous year, although towards the end of the year, the difference which had been 17 million pounds on February 1 decreased to 4 million pounds on December 1.

From May 1 to September 1 inclusive and at December 1 stocks of all meat were higher than during 1946, but in all other months they were less. The grand total of pork holdings was greater than in 1946 at each reporting date except April 1, May 1 and June 1.

Stocks of frozen fresh and frozen smoked fish during the year were larger than in 1946 with the exception of October 1 and December 1, when the stocks were slightly lower.

Stocks of Canadian apples in storage were higher than in 1946 from January 1 to August 1, inclusive, but tended to be lower for the balance of the year with the exception of the stock figure at November 1.

The compilation of these data would be impossible without the assistance of members of the staffs of the firms who complete the monthly schedules and also of the help of Dominion and Provincial officials throughout Canada, to all of whom grateful acknowledgment is extended.
