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

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

SUMMARY

Butter production was at record levels during 1961 and there was a very marked accumulation in stocks of both butter and butter oil. While the net increase in creamery butter stocks alone was about 13 million pounds—from 113.8 to 126.8 million the combined stocks of butter and butter oil (the latter in butter equivalent) rose from 133.3 million pounds at the beginning of the year to 197.2 million at year-end. Lowest volume of the combined stocks in storage was 111.4 million pounds at April 1 and the seasons' high was 211.9 million pounds at November 1 after which the usual winter out-of-storage movement exceeded in-put. Accumulation of stocks was enhanced not only by increased production but also by a further decline in per-capita consumption of butter.

Cheddar cheese stocks were moderately greater than in 1960 at most reporting dates in 1961 and appreciably above average holdings during the 5 year period 1956-60. The seasonal pattern was normal. Stocks decreased from 55.8 million pounds at the beginning of the year to 43.1 million at April 1, then increased through the summer production period to 71.8 million at October 1 and worked down to 64.0 million pounds at year-end, a net increase of 8.2 million pounds for the year. Stocks of other varieties of cheese and process cheese fluctuated within moderate ranges but were slightly above year-earlier totals at the end of 1961.

In contrast to the situation in 1960 when manufacturers' stocks of evaporated whole milk were consistently below 5 year average holdings they were appreciably above average during 1961. The net increase for the year amounted to 16.7 million pounds with year-end carry-over at 60.2 million pounds. Stocks ranged from the low of 24.1 million pounds at April 1 to 81.1 million, the seasons' high, at October 1.

Skim milk powder stocks stood at 23.2 million pounds at the beginning of the year. Month-to-month increases from May through October brought holdings at November 1 to 53.7 million pounds. A very strong out-of-storage movement during the last two month of the year reduced stocks to 30.4 million pounds at year-end which was 10.2 million pounds higher than last year but about 4.5 million below the 5 year average.

Volume of shell eggs carried in storage fluctuated within the narrow range of 38 to 71 thousand cases indicating uniform clearance of egg supplies with no pronounced seasonal build-up of stocks. The same situation applied to frozen egg inventories which were reduced from 5.8 to 2.9 million pounds during 1961.

Poultry meat storage inventory during the early months of 1961 was moderately below the 5 year average of stocks. Consistently high production of broiler chicken through the summer and fall, and record turkey production resulted in sharply increasing stocks from 17.9 to 65.8 million pounds between August 1 and December 1. These December 1 holding were about 15.6 million pounds above the 5 year average of reported stocks. However, due to the fact that some storage facilities not previously listed for reporting stocks were reporting in late 1961, it is estimated that the actual difference from the 5 year average at December 1 was approximately 10 million pounds. Out-of-storage movement was strong during December and year-end carry-over was only very moderately above the average for the last 5 years.

The seasonal peak holdings of cold storage and fresh pork products at May 1 amounted to 39.7 million pounds in 1961 compared with 1956-60 average stocks of 62.3 million pounds at this reporting date. Production and consumption of pork were in closer balance. The smaller accumulation of pork stocks was reflected in total meat holdings since variations from normal in beef and veal inventories were not significant.

Total stocks of fruit held in frozen form and in preservatives averaged 5 to 6 million pounds less than in 1960 during the first six months of 1961 but accumulated inventories by October 1 reached 52.5 million pounds, about 9 million greater than the 5 year average and 1960 holdings at the end of the production season. Stocks of blueberries, cherries and strawberries were higher than normal.

Peak holdings of apples at November 1, 1961 at 9.7 million bushels were about 1.5 million bushels greater than in 1960. Year-end carry-over amounted to 6.1 million bushels compared to 4.8 last year and a five-year average of 5.2 million bushels.








