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

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

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THE FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1943.

The development of the canned foods industry has effected a great change in the relation of foods to seasons. Fruits and vegetables of many kinds are to be had at all times of the year, not always with all the flavour of the freshly gathered products, but with much of their original freshness and flavour. The producers in the country are provided with an enormously extended market for their products and the consumers in both city and country with cheap and wholesome food in great variety.

The number of plants in operation increased from 379 in 1942 to 382 in 1943, and the capital investment rose from \$54,798,625 to \$60,753,837. The average number of employees per annum decreased from 12,304 to 11,894, salaries and wages increased from \$11,487,840 to \$12,350,468, but the value of production fell from \$73,569,273 to \$72,228,697 and the amount paid for materials also decreased from \$45,135,269 to \$44,564,481. During the decade preceding the war the volume of fruit and vegetable preparations produced increased over 54 per cent. This growth is indeed remarkable and represents a substantial increase in the domestic demand for these products. The industry, besides supplying the domestic market, also has a substantial exportable surplus.

The statistics published in the present report include only the statistics of establishments engaged in canning, evaporating, preserving and freezing of fruits and vegetables and the manufacture of vinegar, cider, pickles, catsups, etc. Statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production for Canada, since many products, such as peanut butter, jelly powders, etc., are also found as secondary products of other industries. For the total production reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products appearing in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada" published annually.

The most important branch of this industry is the canning of fruits and vegetables which is carried on most extensively in Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec where climatic conditions for the growing of fruits and vegetables are favourable. The canning season begins in June and continues throughout the summer and autumn until October, being at its height in September. In September of 1943, there were 21,355 wage-earners employed in this industry, while in April, the month of lowest employment, there were only 5,640 employed.

The physical volume of production of canned fruits, canned vegetables, and other products made by the industry during 1943 was about 13 per cent lower than the previous year, while the dollar value of the output declined only by 1.8 per cent. There was thus a rise in the selling value of the products made. There were decreases of 43 per cent in the volume of canned fruits, 40 per cent in canned vegetables, and 10 per cent in catsup and sauces. Jams, jellies and marmalades advanced 25 per cent and canned soups of all kinds 17 per cent.

The tables following give detailed statistics of products made, materials used, capital invested, employment, salaries and wages, etc.

^x The apparent increase in employment for these years is due to a change in the method of computing the average annual employment of wage-earners. From 1925 to 1930 the average was obtained by summing the averages of the individual plants, based on the number of months in actual operations, and not by dividing by twelve the sum of the monthly employment. For example, if a plant operated only during three months of the year with an employment of 100 persons for the first month, 125 the second month and 75 the third month, its average annual employment was taken as 100 (300 divided by 3), while in other years the average was taken as 25 (300 divided by 12).
