

THE FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1945

The development of the canned foods industry has effected a great change in the relation of foods to seasons. Fruits and vegetables of many kinds are to be had at all times of the year, not always with all the flavour of the freshly gathered products, but with much of their original freshness and flavour. The producers in the country are provided with an enormously extended market for their products and the consumers in both city and country with cheap and wholesome food in great variety.

The number of plants in operation increased from 458 in 1944 to 470 in 1945. The average number of employees, however, declined from 15,368 to 14,440 with a decrease in the salary and wage payments from \$16,411,988 to \$16,117,172. The value of production was also lower, having declined from \$107,335,254 to \$99,371,391 while the cost of materials used dropped from \$63,223,982 to \$59,712,161. During the decade preceding the war the volume of fruit and vegetable preparations produced increased over 54 per cent. This growth is indeed remarkable and represents a substantial increase in the domestic demand for these products. The industry, besides supplying the domestic market, also has a substantial exportable surplus.

The statistics published in the present report include only the statistics of establishments engaged in canning, evaporating, preserving and freezing of fruits and vegetables and the manufacture of vinegar, cider, pickles, catsups, etc. Statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production for Canada, since many products, such as peanut butter, jelly powders, etc., are also found as secondary products of other industries. For the total production, reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products appearing in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada" published annually.

The most important branch of this industry is the canning of fruits and vegetables which is carried on most extensively in Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec where climatic conditions for the growing of fruits and vegetables are favourable. The canning season begins in June and continues throughout the summer and autumn until October, being at its height in September. In September of 1945 there were 25,903 wage-earners employed in this industry, while in May, the month of lowest employment, there were only 7,667 employed.

Nineteen forty-five was another poor year for the industry, the physical volume of production of canned fruits, canned vegetables and other products made by the industry declined by 11.7 per cent, while the dollar value of the output declined by only 7 per cent. There was thus a slight rise in the selling value of the products made. There was a drop of 17 per cent in the volume of canned fruits, 16 per cent in canned vegetables, 26 per cent in jams, jellies and marmalades, and 30 per cent in catsup and sauces. The volume of soups on the other hand, was one per cent higher, while pickles and relishes increased by 20 per cent.

The tables following give detailed statistics of products made, materials used, employment, salaries and wages paid, imports and exports, etc.
