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

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THE FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1946

The development of the canned foods industry has effected a great change in the relation of foods to seasons. Fruits and vegetables of many kinds are to be had at all times of the year, not always with all the flavour of the freshly gathered products, but with much of their original freshness and flavour. The producers in the country are provided with an enormously extended market for their products and the consumers in both city and country with cheap and wholesome food in great variety.

The number of plants in operation increased from 470 in 1945 to 513 in 1946. The average number of employees, also increased from 14,440 to 16,373 with an increase in the salary and wage payments from \$16,117,172 to \$19,168,778. The value of production was also higher, having increased from \$99,371,391 to \$136,004,138 while the cost of materials used increased from \$59,712,161 to \$83,434,146. During the decade preceding the war the volume of fruit and vegetable preparations produced increased over 54 per cent. This growth is indeed remarkable and represents a substantial increase in the domestic demand for these products. The industry, besides supplying the domestic market, also has a substantial exportable surplus.

The statistics published in the present report include only the statistics of establishments engaged in canning, evaporating, preserving and freezing of fruits and vegetables and the manufacture of vinegar, cider, pickles, catsups, etc. Statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production for Canada, since many products, such as peanut butter, jelly powders, etc., are also found as secondary products of other industries. For the total production, reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products appearing in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada" published annually.

The most important branch of this industry is the canning of fruits and vegetables which is carried on most extensively in Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec where climatic conditions for the growing of fruits and vegetables are favourable. The canning season begins in June and continues throughout the summer and autumn until October, being at its height in September. In September of 1946 there were 30,976 wage-earners employed in this industry, while in March, the month of lowest employment, there were only 7,978 employed.

Nineteen forty-six was a banner year for this industry, the gross value of production, number of employees and salaries and wages paid being the highest on record. The physical volume of production was also at all-time high, having exceeded the previous high mark attained in 1944. On the basis of 1935-39 equalling 100, the index of the volume of production stood at 175.4, compared with 161.3 in 1944 and 109.9 in 1939. Compared with 1945, canned fruits were up 82 per cent, canned vegetables 27 per cent, jams, jellies and marmalades 6 per cent, soups 56 per cent, catsup and sauces 30 per cent, while pickles and relishes were down 2 per cent. All told there was an increase of 31 per cent in the volume of production and an increase of 37 per cent in the value.

The tables following give detailed statistics of products made, materials used, employment and salaries and wages paid, imports and exports, etc.

Considerable interest exists concerning the extent to which the processing of fruits in SC2 for later use in jams, jellies, marmalades, etc. affects the disposal of the fruit crop, and the table following presents the first results of an attempt to secure a statistical picture.




