

THE FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1947

The development of the canned foods industry has effected a great change in the relation of foods to seasons. Fruits and vegetables of many kinds are to be had at all times of the year, not always with all the flavour of the freshly gathered products, but with much of their original freshness and flavour. The producers in the country are provided with an enormously extended market for their products and the consumers in both city and country with cheap and wholesome food in great variety.

The number of plants in operation decreased from 513 in 1946 to 502 in 1947. The average number of employees increased from 16,373 to 17,033 with an increase in the salary and wage payments from \$19,168,778 to \$22,199,466. The value of production was also higher, having increased from \$136,004,138 to \$152,712,901 while the cost of materials used increased from \$83,434,146 to \$89,332,550. During the decade preceding the war the volume of fruit and vegetable preparations produced increased over 54 per cent. This growth is indeed remarkable and represents a substantial increase in the domestic demand for these products. The industry, besides supplying the domestic market, also has a substantial exportable surplus.

The statistics published in the present report include only the statistics of establishments engaged in canning, evaporating, preserving and freezing of fruits and vegetables and the manufacture of vinegar, cider, pickles, catsups, etc. Statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production for Canada, since many products, such as peanut butter, jelly powders, etc., are also found as secondary products of other industries. For the total production, reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products appearing in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada" published annually.

The most important branch of this industry is the canning of fruits and vegetables which is carried on most extensively in Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec where climatic conditions for the growing of fruits and vegetables are favourable. The canning season begins in June and continues throughout the summer and autumn until October, being at its height in September. In September of 1947 there were 30,769 wage-earners employed in this industry, while in March, the month of lowest employment, there were only 7,949 employed.

The industry in 1947 again operated at a high level. The gross value of production increased 12.3 per cent over 1946 to reach a new record of \$152,712,901. Average number of employees at 17,036 and salaries and wages paid at \$22,199,466 were also the highest yet attained. The volume of production however, was slightly lower than the previous year which was at an all-time high. Compared with 1946, canned fruits increased 40.2 per cent followed by pickles and relishes with 36.1 per cent; jams, jellies and marmalades with 27.3 per cent and catsups and sauces with 15.7 per cent. Soups and canned vegetables decreased 23 per cent and 10 per cent respectively.

The tables following give detailed statistics of products made, materials used, employment and salaries and wages paid, imports and exports, etc.
