

THE FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY

1954

From a very modest beginning just before the turn of the century, commercialized canning has developed into an industry which is now firmly rooted in every province of this Dominion. The Fruit and Vegetable Preparations Industry, in addition to providing an annual outlet for enormous quantities of agricultural products, has succeeded in marketing an extensive and varied range of wholesome appetizing foods. After slightly more than fifty years of operation, the urban or rural consumers may select their favourite brand in a choice of several grades and sizes to meet their immediate need. In addition to the Canadian market, the industry annually exports large quantities of its products to foreign countries, notably Great Britain and the United States.

In 1952, the Bureau changed its policy with regard to the collection of statistics on the production of manufactured goods. Firms in several industries, where year and inventory changes were known to be insignificant, were requested to report value of shipments F.O.B. plant instead of gross value of production. However, this new concept was not adopted in the Fruit and Vegetable Preparations Industry until 1954. Therefore, statistics in this issue relating specifically to the year 1954 are on a shipments basis while data for 1953 and previous years is on a selling value of products basis. Since the change in the value of inventories was insignificant in 1954 compared to 1953, it is assumed that production and shipments data are comparable.

In 1954 the total value of factory shipments was \$215,030,451, an increase of approximately \$10 million from \$205,119,469 reported as the total value of production in 1953. During the decade immediately preceding the war, the volume of fruit and vegetable preparations produced increased over 54 per cent. In spite of curtailment of supplies during the war years the production trend continued upward. In 1949 there was a slight fall-off due partly to a large carryover of these commodities and partly to economic conditions. From 1953 to 1954, the number of operating plants decreased from 454 to 453. In the same period, the average number of employees increased from 15,385 to 15,815. An increase of almost \$2 million in salaries and wages was paid when \$34,714,828 was reported in 1954.

The statistics published in the present report include only the statistics of establishments engaged in canning, evaporating, preserving and freezing of fruits and vegetables and the manufacture of vinegar, cider, pickles, catsups, etc. Statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production for Canada, since many products, such as peanut butter, jelly powders, etc., are also found as secondary products of other industries. For the total production, reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products appearing in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada" published annually.

The most important branch of this industry is the canning of fruits and vegetables which is carried on most extensively in Ontario, British Columbia and Quebec where climatic conditions for the growing of fruits and vegetables are most favourable. The canning season begins in June and continues throughout the summer and autumn until October being at its height in September. In September of 1954 there were 27,354 wage earners employed in this industry, while in January, the month of lowest employment, there were 6,584 persons employed.

In 1954 the selling value of shipments data may be converted to gross value of production by respectively adding or subtracting the change in the inventory of finished goods (see table 6). For 1953 and previous years the gross value of production is given. Value added by manufacturers may then be determined by subtracting the total cost of raw materials plus fuel and electricity. In 1954 the gross value of production of the industry increased almost 1 per cent, while the volume of production increased slightly more than 6 per cent. There was an increase of 25.6 per cent in the volume of canned fruits, 7.8 per cent in jams, jellies and marmalades, 1.2 per cent in canned vegetables, 11.8 per cent in canned soups, 7.8 per cent in catsups, while pickles, relishes and sauces remained almost constant compared to 1953.

Data on the inventories of finished goods, goods in process and raw materials and supplies are shown in Table 6. Other detailed statistics will be found in the following tables for such items as selling value of shipments, materials used, employment, salaries and wages paid, imports and exports, etc.

1. Profits or losses cannot be estimated from Census figures, as no data are collected for certain expense items such as interest, rent, depreciation, taxes, insurance, advertising, etc.

2. Value added by manufacture is computed by subtracting cost of materials, fuel and electricity from gross value of production. In 1954 value of production was obtained by adding or subtracting the change in finished goods inventory from the value of shipments.

3. Prior to 1954 the basis of collection was gross value of production.

4. In order not to divulge operations of individual establishments Newfoundland and Saskatchewan have been combined in 1953 and 1954.


