ESTIMATES OF PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION OF MEATS - CANADA, 1948

Ottawa, April 8, 1949: The Dominion Bureau of Statistics issues today estimates of total meat production, the output of meats from animals slaughtered in Canada and the consumption of meats in Canada in 1948. These estimates are based on information obtained in the live-stock surveys and on reports of marketings and slaughter of live stock in Canada.

S.UMMARY

Total production of meat, excluding offals, from cattle, hogs, sheep and lambs slaughtered in Canada, together with the estimated meat equivalent of animals exported alive was 2,235 million pounds, an increase of 3 per cent over 2,169 million pounds produced in 1947. Total production of beef and veal increased 9.7 and 13.4 per cent respectively while there was a decrease of 3.2 per cent in pork and 26.4 per cent in mutton and lamb from 1947.

The estimated output of meats and offals from animals slaughtered in Canada in 1948 was 2,113 million pounds as compared with 2,220 million pounds in 1947. Output of all meats and offals except veal was less than in 1947. Veal output increased 13 per cent while the decreases in other products were: beef, 7.4 per cent; mutton and lamb, 29.4 per cent; pork, 3.2 per cent; offals, 1.8 per cent. Consumption of meat per capita during 1948 was 135.3 pounds as compared with 146 pounds in 1947. Per capita consumption in 1948 by kinds of meat, 1947 figures in brackets, was: beef, 58 (67.7) pounds; veal, 10.9 (9.6) pounds; mutton and lamb, 3.5 (4.8) pounds; pork, 54.2 (52.7) pounds; offals, 6.0 (6.5) pounds; canned meats, 2.7 (4.7) pounds.

Exports of meats totalled almost 409 million pounds in 1948, a decline of 2 per cent from the 1947 exports. Increased quantities of beef offset the drop in exports of canned meats and pork. Stocks of meat, excluding canned meats, were 116.5 million pounds at the beginning, and 80 million pounds at the end of 1948.
