ESTIMATES OF PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION OF MEATS, 1965

Per capita disappearance of red meats in 1965 declined by 2.8 pounds to 146.3 from 149.1 pounds in 1964, but is still 2.6 per cent above the five year average, 1960 - 1964 inclusive. Increases of 0.2 and 1.1 pounds per person for beef and veal respectively were not enough to offset decreases of 2.8, 0.6, 0.4 and 0.3 pounds for pork, mutton and lamb, offal and canned meats. A very moderate increase in the per capita disappearance of beef occurred to set a new record high for this meat. Exports of this meat were exceptionally large. Per capita disappearance figures for 1965, with the equivalent 1964 figures in brackets, are beef 78.7 pounds, (78.5); veal 8.0 pounds, (6.9); mutton and lamb 2.8 pounds, (3.4); pork 49.2 pounds, (52.0); offal 3.4 pounds, (3.8); canned meats 4.2 pounds, (4.5).

Domestic production of meat, (Table 2), i.e. slaughter plus the meat equivalent of animals exported alive, is estimated at 3,083 million pounds, up 8.6 per cent from 2,839 million pounds in 1964. In this content beef and veal production increased by 15.0 and 27.3 per cent respectively whereas pork and mutton and lamb production decreased by 3.0 and 13.7 per cent.

Output of meats and offal from livestock slaughtered in Canada, Table 3, includes animals imported alive for slaughter but excludes live exports. The total output in 1965 was 2,971 million pounds up 3.0 per cent from 2,884 million pounds in 1964 and 13.5 per cent above the 1960-1964 average of 2,616 million pounds.

Increases in output of beef, veal, and offal of 6.3, 15.5, and 4.6 per cent more than offset decreases of 3.0 and 15.6 per cent for pork and mutton and lamb.

Exports of meats and offal were 213 million pounds in 1965, up 51.0 per cent from the 141 million pounds exported in 1964, and 69.0 per cent above the 1960-1964 average. Beef and veal exports of 102 million pounds were the highest since 1949 and offal exports of 45 million pounds were a record high.
