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
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ESTIMATES OF PRODUCTION AND DISAPPEARANCE OF MEATS, 1968

Per capita disappearance of red meats in 1968 set a new record at 159.1 pounds up from 157.2 in 1967. This increase over 1967 can be attributed to the disappearance of beef which increased from 84.0 pounds to 86.8 pounds per person. Mutton and lamb was the only other red meat with a greater relative increase in per capita disappearance; it increased from 3.6 pounds in 1967 to 4.2 pounds in 1968. Pork, offal and canned meats remained practically unchanged but veal disappearance per person decreased by about half a pound. Per capita disappearance estimates for 1968 are as follows: beef 86.8 pounds, (84.0 in 1967); veal 6.4 pounds, (7.2); pork 53.6 pounds, (53.8); mutton and lamb 4.2 pounds, (3.6); offal 3.8 pounds, (3.9); canned meats 6.1 pounds, (6.2).

Domestic production of red meats for 1968 (Table 2) is estimated at 3,354 million pounds up about 5 per cent from 3,172 million pounds in 1967. This production estimate includes slaughter plus the meat equivalent of animals exported alive.

Output from meats and offal slaughtered in Canada (Table 3) includes animals imported alive for slaughter but excludes live exports. Output was estimated at 3,314 million pounds in 1968 up 3 per cent from 3,208 million pounds in 1967.

Exports of red meats and offal in 1968 were 178 million pounds, up about 20 per cent from 1967 exports, but only slightly above 1966 exports. Increased exports of beef and veal, and offal largely accounted for this although pork was also up.

This publication includes the 1961-1966 intercensal revisions for per capita disappearance. Estimates have been revised to be in line with the latest Census data.

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ESTIMATIONS DE LA PRODUCTION ET DE LA DISPARITION DE VIANDES, 1968

La disparition par habitant de viandes rouges a atteint un record de 159.1 livres en 1968, à comparer à 157.2 en 1967. La différence est attribuable à l'augmentation de la disparition de boeuf, qui est passée de 84.0 à 86.8 livres par personne. Le mouton et l'agneau ont été la seule autre viande rouge à accuser une augmentation relativement plus forte de la disparition par habitant (3.6 livres en 1967 contre 4.2 livres en 1968). Il n'y a pour ainsi dire pas eu de changement du côté du porc, des abats comestibles et des viandes en boîtes, mais la disparition par habitant de veau a diminué d'environ une demi-livre. Voici les estimations pour 1968: boeuf, 86.8 livres (84.0 en 1967); veau, 6.4 livres (7.2); porc, 53.6 livres (53.8); mouton et agneau, 4.2 livres (3.6); abats comestibles 3.8 livres (3.9) viandes en boîtes, 6.1 livres (6.2).

La production nationale de viandes rouges en 1968 (tableau 2) est évaluée à 3,354 millions de livres, soit environ 5 p. 100 de plus que les 3,172 millions de 1967. Cette estimation comprend l'abattage plus l'équivalent en viande des animaux exportés sur pied.

La production de viandes et d'abats provenant de bestiaux abattus au Canada (tableau 3) comprend les animaux importés sur pied pour l'abattage, mais non les animaux exportés sur pied. La production de 1968 est évaluée à 3,314 millions de livres, soit 3 p. 100 de plus que celle de 1967 (3,208 millions de livres).

Les exportations de viandes rouges et d'abats ont été de 178 millions de livres en 1968, c'est-à-dire environ 20 p. 100 de plus qu'en 1967, mais seulement un peu plus qu'en 1966. Cette augmentation provient en grande partie de l'accroissement des exportations de boeuf, de veau et d'abats; les exportations de porc ont également augmenté.

La publication renferme les rectifications intercensales (1961 à 1966) de la disparition par habitant. Les estimations sont mises en concordance avec les dernières données de recensement.
