

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THE SLAUGHTERING AND MEAT PACKING INDUSTRY

CANADA, 1942

The output of the Canadian slaughtering and meat packing industry in 1942 marks a high record for value, with a total of \$369,047,175. The amount shows an increase over the preceding year of \$72,806,760, or 25 per cent, and an increase over 1940 of \$140,546,688, or 61 per cent. To the total value the meats sold fresh contributed an amount of \$151,623,088, or 41 per cent; the cured meats, \$171,116,072 or 47 per cent; lard and shortening, \$22,563,246, or 6 per cent; hides and skins, \$9,932,841, or 2 per cent; and miscellaneous items (tallow, oils, grease, fertilizer, etc.), \$13,811,928 or 4 per cent.

The most important single item comprises bacon and sides, of which the total quantity was 379,408,058 pounds, and the total value, \$81,053,371 - an increase in quantity, compared with the preceding year, of 22,680,882 pounds, or 6 per cent, and an increase in value of \$13,590,880, or 20 per cent. Second and third respectively, in order of value, are "beef sold fresh" (\$80,771,350) and "pork sold fresh" (\$38,607,179).

Average prices were higher in 1942 for all items. The average price for "bacon and sides" rose to 21.4 cents from 18.9 cents in 1941; beef sold fresh to 15.8 cents from 13.2 cents; and fresh pork to 17.9 cents from 15.1 cents. The average price of lard advanced to 11.7 cents from 9.3 cents; shortening containing no animal fat to 15.2 cents from 10.7 cents; and shortening containing some animal fat to 13.9 cents from 12.3 cents.

There were 148 plants in operation in 1942, distributed by provinces as follows: Ontario, 67; Quebec, 29; Alberta, 17; British Columbia, 11; Manitoba, 11; Saskatchewan, 8; Nova Scotia, 4; New Brunswick, 4; and Prince Edward Island, 1. The total number of plants shows an increase of 2 from the preceding year.

The position occupied by each province in respect to the total value of production for the Dominion is given by percentage as follows: Ontario, 36 per cent; Quebec, 15 per cent; Alberta, 18 per cent; Manitoba, 17 per cent; Saskatchewan, 6 per cent; British Columbia, 5 per cent; and Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, combined 1 per cent.

Note: For most industries the questionnaire of the Census of Industry asks for information concerning the quantity and value of goods manufactured during the year, whether sold or not. This procedure is departed from in the case of the slaughtering and meat packing industry and the inquiry concerning production deals with the sale of the product. The inquiry is thus expressed at the suggestion of the Industrial and Development Council of Canadian Meat Packers, as it is believed that the information can be supplied in this form with greater convenience and accuracy.

THE SLAUGHTERING AND MEAT PACKING INDUSTRY, CANADA

The annual census of the industry aims to include only those establishments which dispose of their product at wholesale: small local butchers whose slaughtering furnish the main supply for their own shops and whose business is entirely of a retail nature are excluded.

In table 1, which follows, will be found the principal statistics of the slaughtering and meat packing industry, in the years 1925 to 1942, while table 2 gives, for the years 1940 to 1942, the items of production, by quantity and value.

- (a) In 1931 there were added to the Bureau's list of slaughtering and meat packing plants a number of small establishments engaged in slaughtering only, and annual reports from these plants have since been included in the compilation of returns of the industry. The addition of these small plants, however, does not affect materially the value of production of the industry, as the combined value of their output would represent not more than four per cent of the total for all plants.

Animals Slaughtered and Materials Used. - The combined value of all items under this classification was \$310,446,760, made up as follows: Animals, slaughtered, \$257,585,809; dressed meat purchased fresh or partially cured, \$20,481,115; poultry, \$5,812,399; vegetable and animal oils, \$9,900,292; and miscellaneous materials, \$16,667,145.
