

THE MISCELLANEOUS FOODS INDUSTRY 1950

The statistics published in the present report refer only to those manufacturing establishments whose principal products are coffee, tea, spices, jelly powders, and all other food products which, owing to the variety of the materials used and the products made, do not lend themselves to a grouping into separate industrial classifications.

In 1950 there were 299 establishments reporting in the above category. These were located provincially as follows: Newfoundland 3, Nova Scotia 10, New Brunswick 8, Quebec 72, Ontario 122, Manitoba 22, Saskatchewan 7, Alberta 15, and British Columbia 40.

These plants reported the employment of 7,129 persons who were paid \$14,198,293 in salaries and wages, and produced goods that had a selling value at the factory of \$179,607,764 from materials costing \$132,139,535. Compared with the previous year there was an increase of \$20,633,220 or 13 per cent in the gross value of production.

The principal commodities, tea and coffee, accounted for more than three quarters of the increase in dollar value of production for this Industry. Roasted coffee increased to \$53,200,585 in 1950 compared to \$41,032,583 in 1949. Likewise, tea blended and packed rose in value in 1950 to \$42,391,709 as against \$38,835,783 in 1949. Other principal items of production are: rice; nuts, roasted and salted; peanut butter; yeast; margarine; jelly powders; flavouring extracts; and spices. The production of these items, together with all other commodities in the Industry, are shown in detail in Tables 2 and 3.

It should be remembered that statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production in Canada, since such products as jams, marmalades, mincemeat, fountain fruits, peanut butter, confectionery, etc. are also found as secondary or major products in other industries. For the total production reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products published annually in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada".
