

# THE MISCELLANEOUS FOOD PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY 1951

(Formerly the Miscellaneous Foods Industry)

Beginning in 1951 the Miscellaneous Food Preparations Industry includes statistics on the Starch and Glucose Industry and the Malt and Malt Products Industry, in addition to the various products previously covered under this heading. All tables in this bulletin which show statistics for previous years have been revised to include these industries. The increase in the gross value of production is not entirely due to the added industries since there were substantial gains in several items such as coffee, margarine, peanuts, mayonnaise, etc., which have always been included in this industry.

There are now 328 establishments reporting in this industry, 9 of which are classified in the Starch and Glucose Industry, 13 in the Malt and Malt Products Industry, and 3 in the Rice Mills Industry. These plants reported the employment of 9,194 persons who were paid \$20,965,126 in salaries and wages, and produced goods with a selling value at the factory of \$260,430,714 from materials costing \$192,185,529.

The principal commodities are coffee, tea, and malt. Coffee and tea together account for 40% of the dollar value of production. The quantity of coffee produced in Canada has risen almost without interruption during the last twenty-five years, until in 1951 the poundage is five times the 1926 quantity. Tea has also increased, but only about 50%. Before 1938 more tea than coffee was produced in Canada, but in 1943 coffee distinctly took the lead and increased steadily till 1949, when 70% more coffee than tea was produced.

Other important foods produced in this industry are roasted and salted nuts, margarine, cornstarch, yeast, rice, peanut butter, dehydrated soups, potato chips, jelly powders, etc. Production of these and other items are shown in detail in tables 2 and 3.

It should be remembered that statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total production in Canada, since such products as jams, marmalades, mincemeat, fountain fruits, peanut butter, confectionery, margarine, etc. are also found as secondary or major products in other industries. For the total production reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products published annually in the report "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada".


