

THE MISCELLANEOUS FOOD PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1953

(Formerly the Miscellaneous Foods Industry)

Beginning in 1952, the Bureau changed its policy with regard to the collection of statistics on the production of manufactured goods. Firms in several industries, where year-end inventory changes were known to be insignificant, were requested to report value of shipments f.o.b. plant instead of gross value of production. This changeover should result in better consumption data and should, eventually, provide industry with better statistics for economic analysis.

Since 1951 the Miscellaneous Food Preparations Industry includes statistics on the Starch and Glucose Industry and the Malt and Malt Products Industry, in addition to the various products previously covered under this heading. All tables in this bulletin which show statistics for previous years have been revised to include these industries.

There are now 322 establishments reporting in this industry, 6 of which are classified in the Starch and Glucose Industry, 13 in the Malt and Malt Products Industry, and 2 in the Rice Mills Industry. These plants reported the employment of 9,757 persons who were paid \$26,028,134 in salaries and wages, and shipped goods with a selling value at the factory of \$284,366,431 while the cost of materials used was \$200,378,736.

The principal commodities are coffee, tea, and malt. Coffee and tea together account for 39.80 of the dollar value of production. The quantity of roasted and ground coffee produced in Canada has risen almost without interruption during the last twenty-five years, until in 1953 the poundage is almost five times the 1927 quantity, while tea has almost doubled. Before 1938 more tea than coffee was produced in Canada, but in 1943 coffee distinctly took the lead and increased steadily till 1949, when 70% more coffee than tea was produced.

Other important foods produced in this industry are roasted and salted nuts, margarine, cornstarch, yeast, rice, peanut butter, dehydrated soups, potato chips, jelly powders, etc. Production and shipments of these and other items are shown in detail in tables 2 and 3.

It should be remembered that statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total for Canada, since such products as jams, marmalades, mincemeat, fountain fruits, peanut butter, confectionery, margarine, etc. are also found as secondary or major products in other industries. For total production and shipments reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products published annually in the report "The General Review of Foods and Beverages" or "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada".

In 1953 statistics on power equipment and fuel consumption were collected for the first time since 1948. Tables 10 and 11 show the results of this survey.
