

THE MISCELLANEOUS FOOD PREPARATIONS INDUSTRY, 1957

(Formerly the Miscellaneous Foods Industry)

Beginning in 1952, the Bureau changed its policy with regard to the collection of statistics on the production of manufactured goods. Firms in several industries, where year-end inventory changes were known to be insignificant, were requested to report value of shipments f.o.b. plant instead of gross value of production. This change-over should result in better consumption data and should, eventually, provide industry with better statistics for economic analysis.

Since 1951 the Miscellaneous Food Preparations Industry includes statistics on the Starch and Glucose Industry and the Malt and Malt Products Industry, in addition to the various products previously covered under this heading. All tables in this bulletin which show statistics for previous years have been revised to include these industries.

In 1955 manufacturers whose main products are roasted peanuts or ready-to-eat-popcorn were withdrawn from the Miscellaneous Food Preparations Industry and added to the Confectionery Industry in accordance with Standard Industrial Classification recommendations. These are now compiled with the Confectionery Industry. Principal statistics in Table 1 have been decreased back to and including 1937 by deleting the firms who were operating in these respective years. All other tables providing 1954 figures have been revised to exclude the respective data for these firms.

Inventory values of raw materials and supplies, goods in process, and finished goods of own manufacture were collected for the first time in 1954. The 1957 figures are recorded in Table 2.

Value added by manufacture (net value) is shown in Table 1, column 6. From 1930 to 1951, the value added by manufacture is computed by subtracting the cost of materials used and cost of fuel and electricity from value of production. In 1952 and 1953 value of shipments was used since value of production could not be ascertained. In 1954 and 1955 value of production was computed by using the value of shipments plus or minus the increase or decrease in finished goods inventory. For 1956 and 1957, the change in "Goods in process" inventory was also taken into account. In

the illustrative table below, value of shipments shown in column 1 include manufacturers whose main products are roasted peanuts and ready-to-eat popcorn. They, therefore, do not agree with gross selling values as shown in Table 1, column 7, for the years 1951-1954 inclusive since in the latter these manufacturers were excluded to make this historical table uniform for the period 1937-57. In the 1958 report Table 1 will be revised to include these manufacturers for all years prior to 1955. These two tables will then be identical for the period covered by the illustrative table. Technical difficulties prevented this being done for 1957.

There are now 308 establishments reporting in this industry, 6 of which are classified in the Starch and Glucose Industry, 12 in the Malt and Malt Products Industry, and 2 in the Rice Mills Industry. These plants reported the employment of 10,003 persons who were paid \$32,561,621 in salaries and wages, and shipped goods with a selling value at the factory of \$336,291,786 while the cost of materials used was \$227,639,112.

The principal commodities are coffee, tea, and malt. Coffee and tea together account for 34.23% of the dollar value of shipments. The quantity of roasted and ground coffee produced in Canada has risen almost without interruption during the last twenty-five years, except in 1954 when the quantity shipped decreased by over 9 million pounds.

Other important foods produced in this industry are margarine, cornstarch, yeast, rice, peanut butter, potato chips, jelly powders, etc. Shipments of these and other items are shown in detail in Tables 6 and 7.

It should be remembered that statistics relating to specific products are not to be regarded as the total for Canada, since such products as jams, marmalades, mincemeat, fountain fruits, peanut butter, confectionery, margarine, etc. are also found as secondary or major products in other industries. For total production and shipments reference should be made to the alphabetical list of products published annually in the report "The General Review of Foods and Beverages" or "The Manufacturing Industries of Canada".
