COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JANUARY 1, 1927

The butter in storage amounts to 14,117,034 pounds of creamery and 431,393 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 42.96% over last year and a decrease of 27.04% from last month and dairy butter also shows an increase of 206.05% over last year and a decrease of 28.15% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 23,302,293 pounds in store showing an increase of 3.98% over last year and a decrease of 11.16% from last month.

Eggs show 1,211,395 dozen in cold storage; 315,081 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,000,872 pounds of frozen eggs. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 66.50% from last year and 69.17% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of 14.88% from last year and an increase of 7.18% over last month; while frozen eggs show an increase of 72.37% over last year and a decrease of 13.40% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 10,426,140 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,767,275 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,533,072 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 5,765,612 pounds, and in process of cure 8,738,204 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 166.11% over last year and 71.66% over last month; stocks, not frozen show an increase of 13.11% over last year and a decrease of 10.95% from last month; cured, dry salted shows an increase of 14.86% over last year and a decrease of 7.58% from last month; cured, sweet pickled shows increases of 3.50% over last year and 4.15% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 17.14% over last year and a decrease of 10.14% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,798,123 pounds, showing increases of 29.36% and 16.08% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks amount to 21,254,659 pounds of fresh frozen, 5,363,340 pounds of fresh, not frozen, 258,245 pounds of cured beef and 261,576 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 50.66% over last year and 18.19% over last month; fresh, not frozen show an increase of 16.30% over last year and a decrease of 18.20% from last month; cured beef shows a decrease of 10.86% from last year and an increase of 2.69% over last month; while stocks in process of cure show decreases of 12.92% from last year and 9.72% from last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 2,611,364 pounds of fresh frozen and 336,088 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 46.31% over last year and 10.01% over last month, while stocks, not frozen show an increase of 86.46% over last year and a decrease of 37.74% from last month.

Mutton & Lamb stocks total 5,390,196 pounds of frozen and 237,718 pounds of stocks, not frozen. Frozen stocks show increases of 14.33% over last year and 34.54% over last month, while stocks not frozen show an increase of 54.74% last year and a decrease of 73.98% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 501,306 pounds; chickens 3,253,392 pounds; fowl 1,876,350 pounds; ducks 126,832 pounds; geese 64,075; turkeys 1,254,733 pounds; unclassified 717,384 pounds. Comparative figures show increases in total poultry of 14.77% and 95.77% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks show 14,886,827 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 4,683,358 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 7.89% over last year and a decrease of 24.07% from last month, and other fish in cold storage shows increases of 19.76% over last year and 7.55% over last month.


