COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1, 1927

The butter in storage amounts to 34,358,499 pounds of creamery and 683,393 pounds of dairy. Compared with last year's figures, creamery butter shows an increase of 23.20% and dairy butter an increase of 9.97%; compared with last month's figures creamery butter has decreased 8.05% and dairy butter has increased 7.26%.

Cheese stocks total 29,698,037 pounds which is a decrease of 13.94% from last year and 16.98% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 10,726,747 dozen; other than cold storage 639,081 dozen; and frozen eggs 1,512,420 pounds. Eggs in cold storage show an increase of 36.63% over last year and a decrease of 16.25% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 21.51% over last year and a decrease of 15.79% from last month; and frozen eggs show increase of 7.72% and 5.19% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,884,250 pounds; fresh nor frozen, 3,200,041 pounds; cured, dry salted, 1,532,253 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,644,657 pounds and in process of cure 8,046,247 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows increases of 42.31% over last year and 2.95% over last month; fresh, not frozen pork shows increases of 9.67% over last year and 27.29% over last month; cured, dry salted pork shows a decrease of 5.63% from last year and an increase of 25.53% over last month; sweet pickled pork shows an increase of 5.04% over last year and a decrease of 15.08% from last month; and pork in process of cure shows a decrease of 14.54% from last year and an increase of .66% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,350,440 pounds, which is an increase of 3.05% over last year and a decrease of 21.59% from last month.

Beef stocks in storage show 8,842,619 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,426,163 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 156,225 pounds of cured; and 242,451 pounds in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks have increased 13.70% and 88.65% over last year and last month respectively and fresh, not frozen stocks have increased 1.28% and 8.52%; cured stocks show decreases of 44.64% and 42.96% respectively and stocks in process of cure have decreased 30.08% from last year and increased 29.25% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,166,226 pounds of fresh frozen, and 532,068 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks have decreased 27.77% from last year and increased 44.72% over last month, and fresh, not frozen stocks have decreased 11.23% from last year and increased 4.83% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,161,955 pounds of fresh frozen and 564,009 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 65.84% and 416.94% over last year and last month and not frozen stocks show a decrease of 1.78% from last year and an increase of 13.43% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers, 364,591 pounds; chickens 758,664 pounds; fowl 506,641 pounds; ducks 88,941 pounds; geese 33,757 pounds; turkeys 406,378 pounds; and unclassified 242,348 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 39.31% over last year and 7.23% over last month.

Fish stocks total 19,489,675 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,164,948 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows decreases of 10.98% and 9.32% from last year and last month respectively and other fish in cold storage shows an increase of 38.06% over last year and a decrease of 17.63% from last month.

During the month of October 5,210,641 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,669,240 pounds during the month of September.


