COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, FEBRUARY 1, 1927.

The butter in storage amounts to 8,901,953 pounds of creamery and 494,350 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 61.63% over last year and a decrease of 36.94% from last month while dairy butter shows increases of 535.73% over last year and 14.59% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 17,940,960 pounds in store showing decreases of 1.12% and 23.01% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs show 192,064 dozen in cold storage; 307,204 dozen other than cold storage eggs and 1,233,387 pounds of frozen stocks. The eggs in cold storage show decreases of 87.71% from last year and 84.23% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 7.94% over last year and a decrease of 2.50% from last month, while frozen eggs show increases of .86% over last year and 23.23% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 16,317,553 pounds; fresh, not, frozen 4,732,118 pounds; dry salted 1,304,961 pounds; sweet pickled 6,016,956 pounds; in process of cure 10,451,769 pounds. Comparative figures show the following increases in stocks of fresh pork, frozen 153.09% over last year and 56.51% over last month and not frozen 51.46% over last year and 71.00% over last month. Cured, dry salted pork shows decreases of 34.54% from last year and 14.88% from last month and cured, sweet pickled shows an increase of 7.40% over last year and a decrease of 11.07% from last month. Stocks in process of cure show increases of 17.13% over last year and 19.61% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,676,788 pounds showing increases of 35.92% and 31.40% over last year and last month, respectively.

Beef stocks in store show 18,878,361 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,373,589 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 285,064 pounds of cured and 264,604 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows an increase of 110.19% over last year and a decrease of 11.18% from last month and fresh, not frozen, shows increases of 24.78% over last year and 18.24% over last month. Cured beef shows increases over last year of 15.25% and over last month of 10.39%, and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 12.49% over last year and 1.16% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,793,401 pounds of fresh frozen and 226,066 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Comparative figures show increases over last year of 49.72% in frozen stocks and 31.63% in stocks, not frozen; while comparisons with last month's figures show decreases of 31.32% in frozen and 32.74% in fresh, not frozen, stocks.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 5,048,309 pounds of frozen and 193,368 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 18.38% over last year and a decrease of 6.34% from last month. Stocks, not frozen, show decreases of 4.22% and 18.66% from last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 490,378 pounds; chickens 3,577,770 pounds; fowl 1,478,174 pounds; ducks 120,570 pounds; geese 115,360 pounds; turkeys 1,116,884 pounds; unclassified 700,004 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 23.22% over last year and a decrease of 2.50% from last month.

Fish stocks show 15,244,645 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 3,258,246 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Comparative figures show increases in fresh frozen fish of 23.18% over last year and 2.10% over last month; while other fish in cold storage shows decreases of 28.38% and 30.43% from last year and last month respectively.


