COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MARCH 1, 1927.

The Butter in storage amounts to 6,547,180 pounds of creamery and 375,357 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 100.47% over last year and a decrease of 26.99% from last month and dairy butter also shows an increase of 139.44% over last year and a decrease of 24.05% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 16,182,769 pounds in store showing an increase of 7.16% over last year and a decrease of 9.77% from last month.

Eggs show 111,322 dozen in cold storage; 364,437 dozen other than cold storage and 1,098,913 pounds of frozen eggs. The eggs in cold storage show decreases of 70.93% from last year and 42.04% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show a decrease of 12.30% from last year and an increase of 16.14% over last month, while frozen eggs show an increase of 5.84% over last year and a decrease of 10.89% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- Fresh frozen 20,602,911 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,599,765 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,450,866 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,778,653 pounds; in process of cure 10,270,239 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows increases of 127.07% and 26.07% over last year and last month respectively. Fresh pork, not frozen shows an increase of 24.90% over last year and a decrease of 24.39% from last month; cured, dry salted shows increases of 5.22% over last year and 11.18% over last month; cured, sweet pickled shows a decrease of 11.36% from last year and an increase of 12.60% over last month; while stocks in process of cure show an increase of 16.12% over last year and a decrease of 2.10% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,484,346 pounds showing increases of 30.08% and 21.60% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks in store show 17,099,450 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,493,103 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 310,054 pounds of cured and 380,141 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows an increase of 219.82% over last year and a decrease of 9.42% from last month, while not frozen shows decreases of 1.01% from last year and 29.49% from last month. Cured beef shows increases of 38.12% over last year and 3.77% over last month and stocks in process of cure also show increases of 121.58% and 44.58% over last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,021,756 pounds of fresh frozen and 210,227 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Compared with last year's figures fresh frozen veal shows an increase of 54.78% and fresh, not frozen also an increase of 49.11%; while comparisons with last month's figures show decreases of 39.58% in fresh frozen and 6.90% in fresh not frozen stocks.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 4,206,424 pounds of frozen and 121,781 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 16.59% over last year and a decrease of 16.77% from last month, while stocks, not frozen also show an increase of 22.13% over last year and a decrease of 36.79% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- Broilers 452,229 pounds; chickens 3,338,783 pounds; fowl 1,364,523 pounds; ducks 86,362 pounds; geese 47,359 pounds; turkeys 1,251,024 pounds; unclassified 447,682 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 21.51% over last year and a decrease of 3.07% from last month.

Fish stocks show 14,049,289 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 2,929,692 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish show an increase of 46.76% over last year and a decrease of 5.73% from last month, while other fish in cold storage shows an increase of 26.72% over last year and a decrease of 10.08% from last month.


