COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MAY 1st, 1927.

The butter in storage amounts to 1,287,502 pounds of creamery and 218,851 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 54.36% from last year and 24.82% from last month while dairy butter shows increases of 1,391.83% over last year and 5.42% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 10,356,285 pounds in store showing decreases of 12.96% from last year and 19.59% from last month.

Eggs show 4,894,442 dozen in cold storage; 456,543 dozen, other than cold storage and 690,900 pounds of frozen eggs. The eggs in cold storage show increases of 38.51% over last year and 758.12% over last month; other than cold storage show an increase of 3.68% over last year and a decrease of 21.65% from last month; while frozen eggs show decreases of 26.71% and 18.98% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 24,076,965 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,699,109 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,777,961 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,627,418 pounds; in process of cure 11,285,090 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows increases of 82.63% over last year and 8.30% over last month; while fresh, not frozen stocks show decreases of 9.00% from last year and 11.54% from last month. Compared with last year's figures cured, dry salted stocks show a decrease of 15.89% and cured, sweet pickled an increase of 6.60%, while compared with last month decreases of 9.78% in dry salted and 6.35% in sweet pickled stocks are shown. Stocks, in process of cure show increases of 20.01% over last year and 3.93% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,013,483 pounds showing increases of 11.61% and 11.62% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks in store show 10,633,232 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,733,376 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 361,888 pounds of cured and 245,683 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows an increase of 163.87% over last year and a decrease of 25.35% from last month and beef, not frozen shows decreases of 10.25% from last year and .60% from last month. Cured beef shows increases of 126.58% over last year and 11.46% over last month and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 26.77% over last year and 23.79% of a decrease from last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 621,517 pounds of fresh frozen and 364,529 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Frozen veal shows an increase of 90.84% over last year and a decrease of 18.75% from last month and stocks not frozen show increases of 8.22% and 1.67% over last year and last month respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 2,346,442 pounds of frozen and 96,863 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 27.72% over last year and a decrease of 30.53% from last month and stocks, not frozen show increases of 53.85% over last year and 8.65% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 280,246 pounds; chickens 2,507,922 pounds; fowl 1,002,998 pounds; ducks 98,621 pounds; geese 32,702 pounds; turkey 1,005,442 pounds; unclassified 391,012 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 57.36% over last year and a decrease of 17.37% from last month.

Fish stocks show 12,066,700 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,356,913 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 80.30% over last year and a decrease of 7.67% from last month, while other fish in cold storage show increases of 93.81% and 12.44% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of April 1927, 1,514,564 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,193,550 pounds last month.
