COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1st, 1927.

The butter in storage amounts to 14,760,749 pounds of creamery and 324,006 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows increases of 2.91% over last year and 270.66% over last month and dairy butter also shows increases of 2.73% over last year and 133.03% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 20,087,568 pounds in store showing increases of 5.85% over last year and 79.92% over last month.

Eggs show 13,780,509 dozen in cold storage; 817,260 dozen, other than cold storage and 1,713,757 pounds of frozen eggs. Eggs in cold storage show increases of 2.38% over last year and 27.82% over last month; other than cold storage eggs show increases of 8.49% over last year and 33.37% over last month and frozen eggs also show increases of 41.23% and 21.51% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 19,005,948 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,775,475 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,232,175 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,859,155 pounds; in process of cure 9,459,030 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows an increase of 53.94% over last year and a decrease of 10.69% from last month, while fresh, not frozen shows increases of 34.69% over last year and 7.82% over last month. Cured dry salted stocks show increases of 39.17% over last year and 32.26% over last month; cured, sweet pickled show a decrease of 13.34% from last year and an increase 1.00% over last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 7.03% over last year and a decrease of 15.61% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 5,979,494 pounds showing increases of 15.58% and 5.79% over last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks in storage show 4,879,774 pounds of fresh frozen; 3,878,829 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 336,636 pounds of cured beef; and 264,446 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows an increase of 80.52% over last year and a decrease of 32.43% from last month and beef, not frozen shows decreases of 22.89% from last year and 4.60% from last month. Cured beef shows an increase of 58.91% over last year and a decrease of 16.27% from last month, and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 79.48% from last year and an increase of 23.54% over last month.


Veal in storage amounts to 836,275 pounds of fresh frozen and 316,852 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen veal shows increases of 53.77% over last year and 8.56% over last month; while veal, not frozen shows decreases of 18.36% from last year and 4.86% from last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 747,523 pounds of frozen and 188,181 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 192.58% over last year and a decrease of 51.46% from last month; while stocks, not frozen also show an increase of 8.77% over last year and a decrease of 19.62% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 267,385 pounds; chickens 1,856,877 pounds; fowl 602,253 pounds; ducks 82,241 pounds; geese 73,254 pounds; turkeys 872,735 pounds; unclassified 175,009 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 88.86% over last year and a decrease of 12.66% from last month.

Fish stocks show 16,573,117 pounds of fresh frozen and 3,226,962 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 41.69% over last year and 32.93% over last month; while other fish in cold storage show decreases of 16.51% and .08% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of June 1927, 3,734,301 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,599,512 pounds last month.
