COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, AUGUST 1, 1927.

The butter in storage amounts to 27,065,219 pounds of creamery and 961,098 pounds of dairy. Compared with the same date last year creamery butter shows a decrease of 3.82% and compared with last month's figures an increase of 82.98%. Dairy butter shows increases of 50.72% and 195.92% over last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 30,254,263 pounds, a decrease of 12.26% from last year and an increase of 50.61% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,599,458 dozen; other than cold storage eggs 467,394 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,018,630 pounds. Eggs in cold storage shows increases of 6.44% and 16.19% over last year and last month; other than cold storage eggs show decreases of 6.49% and 42.69%; and frozen eggs show increases of 52.44% and 17.60% respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 14,920,540 pounds; fresh, not frozen 1,728,944 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,599,695 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,645,499 pounds; and in process of cure 10,373,542 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows an increase of 52.49% over last year and a decrease of 21.53% from last month; fresh, not frozen shows decreases of 26.93% and 39.20% from last year and last month; cured, dry salted shows decreases of 4.67% and 19.72%; cured, sweet pickled shows decreases of 18.24% and 3.45%; pork in process of cure shows increases of 3.97% and 8.42% respectively.

The last lard in storage amounts to 5,358,266 pounds being a decrease of 10.73% from last year and a decrease of 10.07% from last month.

Beef, stocks in storage show 3,748,156 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,281,415 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 397,438 pounds of cured beef; and 218,057 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows an increase of 49.33% over last year and a decrease of 23.22% from last month; fresh, not frozen beef shows increases of 1.81% and 11.00%; cured beef shows increases of 5.48% and 18.06% and beef in process of cure shows decreases of 7.85% and 17.54% over last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 722,076 pounds of fresh frozen and 526,792 pounds of fresh not frozen. Fresh frozen veal stocks have increased 2.49% over last year and decreased 11.74% from last month and fresh veal, not frozen increased 42.94% over last year and 67.89% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 517,878 pounds of frozen and 184,172 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 44.68% over last year and a decrease of 30.69% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show an increase of 17.74% over last year, and a decrease of 2.13% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers, 283,336 pounds; chickens 1,245,171 pounds; fowl 475,640 pounds; ducks 55,722 pounds; geese 35,251 pounds; turkeys 767,733 pounds and unclassified 120,766 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 110.89% over last year and a decrease of 23.64% from last month.

Fish stocks total 17,891,647 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,226,766 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 31.72% over last year and 7.85% over last month; and other fish in cold storage shows increases of 30.30% and 47.52% respectively.

During the month of July 3,204,535 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,734,301 pounds during June.
