COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1927

The butter in storage amounts to 33,741,339 pounds of creamery and 701,924 pounds of dairy. Comparative figures show increases of 3.06% over last year and 24.99% over last month in creamery butter, while dairy butter shows decreases of 45.46% and 26.55% over last year and last month respectively.

Cheese stocks total 35,817,919 pounds, a decrease of 13.76 from last year and an increase of 18.39% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,209,997 dozen; other than cold storage 758,531 dozen; and frozen eggs 1,711,823 pounds. Eggs in cold storage show an increase of 3.71% over last year and a decrease of 6.96% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show increases of 22.12% over last year and 67.28% over last month; and frozen eggs show an increase of 36.90% over last year and a decrease of 14.71% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 10,471,579 pounds; fresh, not frozen 1,809,876 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,260,293 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,696,464 pounds; and in process of cure 10,522,431 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows an increase of 36.70% over last year and a decrease of 29.58% from last month, and fresh pork, not frozen shows a decrease of 15.88% from last year and an increase of 7.39% over last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show an increase of 43% over last year and a decrease of 13.00% from last month; cured, sweet pickled show decreases of 17.13% from last year and 11.79% from last month; and stocks in process of cure show an increase of 11.27% over last year and a decrease of 40.68% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,551,220 pounds showing decreases of 18.33% and 14.85% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks in storage show 3,583,394 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,408,376 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 343,818 pounds of cured beef; and 259,367 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen beef shows an increase of 7.28 over last year and a decrease of 3.45% from last month; fresh, not frozen beef shows increases of 11.40% over last year and 28.56% over last month; cured beef shows an increase of 11.95% over last year and a decrease of 10.69% from last month; and beef in process of cure shows a decrease of 19.39% from last year and an increase of 20.03% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 732,147 pounds of fresh frozen and 511,268 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen veal stocks show a decrease of 18.79% from last year and an increase of 4.31% over last month and fresh veal, not frozen show increases of 78.40% over last year and 6.00% over last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 288,544 pounds of frozen and 229,031 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 78.68% over last year and a decrease of 43.10% from last month; and stocks not frozen show a decrease of 3.50% from last year and an increase of 30.77% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 301,652 pounds; chickens 858,714 pounds; fowl 365,259 pounds; ducks 65,933 pounds; geese 26,866 pounds; turkeys 618,959 pounds; unclassified 120,834 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 113.37% over last year and a decrease of 20.87 from last month.

Fish stocks total 19,722,793 pounds of fresh frozen fish and 5,038,629 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 18.17% and 10.50% over last year and last month respectively; and other fish in cold storage shows an increase of 13.80% over last year and a decrease of 4.58% from last month.

During the month of August 4,143,636 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,204,535 pounds during July.






