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COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JANUARY 1, 1928

The butter in storage amounts to 21,184,694 pounds of creamery and 419,838 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 50.06% over last year and a decrease of 20.91% from last month, and dairy butter shows decreases of 2.68% from last year and 36.71% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 20,842,699 pounds showing decreases of 10.56% and 8.99% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 2,511,037 dozen; other than cold storage 387,943 dozen; and frozen eggs 1,121,475 pounds. Eggs in cold storage show an increase of 106.14% over last year and a decrease of 57.81% from last month; other than cold storage eggs show an increase of 23.12% over last year and a decrease of 17.02% from last month; and frozen eggs also show an increase of 121.05% over last year and a decrease of 23.07% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 14,931,429 pounds; fresh, not frozen 2,482,869 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,132,704 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 8,725,185 pounds; in process of cure 6,791,812 pounds. Fresh frozen pork shows increases of 43.21% over last year and 93.17% over last month while fresh pork, not frozen shows decreases of 10.28% from last year and 40.00% from last month. Cured dry salted stocks show a decrease of 26.12% from last year and an increase of 7.82% over last month; cured sweet pickled stocks show increases of 28.96% over last year and 13.71% over last month; and stocks, in process of cure show decreases of 22.27% from last year and 7.95% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,273,527 pounds showing a decrease of 18.75% from last year and an increase of 6.62% over last month.

Beef stocks in storage amount to 18,138,589 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,338,435 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 139,408 pounds of cured; and 268,553 pounds of stocks, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 14.66% from last year and 1.36% from last month; fresh stocks not frozen show decreases of 19.11% from last year and 35.39% from last month; cured stocks have also decreased 46.02% from last year and 7.67% from last month; while stocks in process of cure show increases of 2.67% over last year and 62.13% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 1,452,278 pounds of fresh frozen and 256,899 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Decreases of 44.39% from last year and 8.60% from last month are shown in fresh frozen stocks, while fresh, not frozen also show decreases of 23.56% and 51.85% from last year and last month respectively.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,901,146 pounds of frozen and 316,158 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 9.07% from last year and 18.25% from last month; and stocks, not frozen show an increase of 33.00% over last year and a decrease of 33.15% from last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 540,051 pounds; chickens 3,936,531 pounds; fowl 1,337,206 pounds; ducks 118,638 pounds; geese 69,896 pounds; turkeys 1,329,081 pounds; unclassified 606,226 pounds. Total poultry shows increases of 1.84% and 101.11% over last year and last month respectively.

Fresh stocks total 17,202,213 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,490,903 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 15.55% over last year and a decrease of 18.45% from last month; while other fish in cold storage shows a decrease of 4.11% from last year and an increase of 21.81% over last month.

During the month of December 2,522,409 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 6,710,320 pounds frozen during the month of November.

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



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
