COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, NOVEMBER 1st, 1928.

The butter in storage amounts to 25,001,388 pounds of creamery and 950,444 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 27.23% from last year and 14.43% from last month; while dairy butter shows increases of 39.08% over last year and 33.13% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 24,380,128 pounds in store showing decreases of 17.91% and 12.32% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 10,318,132 dozen; other than cold storage 453,787 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,504,575 pounds. Cold storage eggs show decreases of 3.81% from last year and 31.96% from last month; eggs, other than cold storage also show decreases of 29.33% from last year and 24.65% from last month, while frozen eggs show increases of 131.72% over last year and 8.19% over last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 5,457,579 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,658,498 pounds; cured, dry salted 1,218,150 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 7,373,851 pounds; in process of cure 5,847,544 pounds. Comparative figures show decreases in fresh frozen stocks of 20.92% from last year and 32.46% from last month; and in fresh stocks, not frozen increases of 13.72% over last year and 2.38% over last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show decreases of 20.50% from last year and 37.68% from last month; cured, sweet pickled show an increase of 10.06% over last year and a decrease of 8.39% from last month; and stocks, in process of cure show decreases of 27.49% and 17.15% from last year and last month respectively.

The lard in storage amounts to 2,661,482 pounds, showing an increase of 13.05% over last year and a decrease of 24.55% from last month.

Beef stocks total 7,149,129 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,333,765 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 156,826 pounds of cured; and 246,612 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 19.15% from last year and an increase of 129.97% over last month; and fresh stocks not frozen also show a decrease of 1.45% from last year and an increase of 5.32% over last month. Cured stocks show an increase of .38% over last year and a decrease of 39.20% from last month; while stocks, not frozen show increases of 1.30% and 41.69% over last year and last month respectively.


Veal in storage amounts to 1,326,096 pounds of fresh frozen and 456,823 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 13.53% over last year and 60.63% over last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen show decreases of 14.14% from last year and 5.95% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 3,147,728 pounds of frozen and 600,941 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show a decrease of .45% from last year and an increase of 327.08% over last month; while frozen stocks show increases of 6.55% and 41.09% over last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 280,495 pounds; chickens 489,288 pounds; fowl 482,627 pounds; ducks 111,159 pounds; geese 17,498 pounds; turkeys 233,291 pounds; unclassified 392,680 pounds. Comparative figures show total poultry to have decreased 16.42% from last year and increased 47.07% over last month.

Fish stocks total 27,105,956 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,483,031 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows increases of 39.08% over last year and 15.71% over last month; while other fish in cold storage also shows increases of 31.65% and 4.90% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of October 4,592,878 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,078,890 pounds frozen during the month of September.



Statement of Food Commodities in storage on November 1, 1928, and a five year average as at November 1st.


