COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, December 1st, 1928.

The butter in storage amounts to 17,218,866 pounds of creamery and 589,142 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 30.98% from last month and 36.22% from last year and dairy butter also shows decreases of 38.04% from last month and 11.18% from last year.

Cheese stocks total 19,529,552 pounds in store showing decreases of 19.89% and 14.71% from last month and last year respectively.

Eggs in storage amount 6,080,357 dozen; other than cold storage 322,596 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,941,726 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 41.36% from last month and an increase of 1.78% over last year; eggs, other than cold storage show decreases of 26.34% from last month and 29.68% from last year; and frozen eggs show a decrease of 15.13% per cent from last month and an increase of 101.79% over last year.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 6,286,360 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,751,888 pounds; cured, dry salted 2,263,920 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 6,555,085 pounds; in process of cure 5,672,005 pounds. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 15.21% over last month and a decrease of 19.90% from last year, and fresh stocks, not frozen also show an increase of 2.54% over last month and a decrease of 9.51% from last year. Cured, dry salted stocks show increases of 85.85% over last month and 115.46% over last year. Cured, sweet pickled show decreases of 10.93% from last month and 14.58% from last year; while stocks in process of cure also show decreases of 3.00% from last month and 23.39% from last year.

The lard in storage amounts to 1,960,668 pounds, showing decreases of 25.99% and 7.20% from last month and last year respectively.

Beef stocks total 13,274,703 pounds of fresh frozen; 6,003,639 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 353,970 pounds of cured; and 84,763 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show an increase of 55.56% over last month and a decrease of 27.58% from last year; and fresh stocks, not frozen show decreases of 4.99% from last month and 10.67% from last year. Cured stocks show increases of 127.12% over last month and 134.03% over last year; while stocks in process of cure show decreases of 65.63% from last month and 48.92% from last year.


Veal in storage amounts to 1,713,549 pounds of fresh frozen and 243,858 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show increases of 30.09% over last month and 6.46% over last year; while stocks not frozen show decreases of 45.04% from last month and 54.40% from last year.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 5,246,351 pounds of frozen and 494,469 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show an increase of 66.74% over last month and a decrease of 12.38% from last year; while stocks, not frozen show a decrease of 17.63% from last month and an increase of 4.27% over last year.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 314,873 pounds; chickens 1,929,943 pounds; fowl 1,111,994 pounds; ducks 115,800 pounds; geese 113,700 pounds; turkeys 225,084 pounds; unclassified 821,942 pounds. Comparative figures show total poultry to have increased 133.48% and 17.96% over last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 11,071,004 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,817,932 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of 9.89% from last month and an increase of 16.49% over last year; while other fish in cold storage shows increases of 6.08% over last month and 57.79% over last year.

During the month of November 5,326,630 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 4,592,878 pounds frozen during October.


