COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, FEBRUARY 1, 1928

The butter in storage amounts to 18,731,024 pounds of creamery and 187,950 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 110.40% over last year and a decrease of 12.35% from last month, while dairy butter shows decreases of 61.20% from last year and 55.35% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 17,362,140 pounds showing decreases of 3.23% and 16.71% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 1,010,232 dozen, having increased 425.99% over last year and decreased 60% from last month. Eggs, other than cold storage, show 321,501 dozen, being an increase of 4.65% over last year and a decrease of 17.94% from last month; while frozen eggs, totalling 1,040,117 pounds, show decreases of 15.67% from last year and 7.27% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 15,950,777 pounds; fresh, not frozen, 7,028,993 pounds; cured, dry salted, 1,273,203 pounds; cured, sweet pickled, 9,673,873 pounds; in process of cure 7,381,218 pounds. Comparative figures show increases in fresh frozen pork of .77% over last year and 6.70% over last month and increases also in fresh pork, not frozen, of 49.52% and 182.32% over last year and last month respectively. Cured, dry salted pork shows a decrease of 3.94% from last year and an increase of 12.39% over last month; while cured sweet pickled shows increases of 61.22% over last year and 10.87% over last month. Stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 29.27% from last year and an increase of 8.68% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,010,926 pounds, showing a decrease of 16.30% from last year and an increase of 32.34% over last month.

Beef stocks in storage amount to 13,887,946 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,582,101 pounds of fresh not frozen; 223,901 pounds of cured beef and 242,677 pounds of beef in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 26.43% from last year and 23.45% from last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen, show a decrease of 12.42% from last year and an increase of 27.85% over last month. Cured stocks show a decrease of 21.46% from last year and an increase of 60.61% over last month, and stocks in process of cure show decreases of 8.29% and 9.65% from last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 883,915 pounds of fresh frozen and 281,648 pounds of fresh not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 50.71% from last year and 39.17% from last month while fresh stocks show increases of 24.59% over last year and 9.38% over last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 4,988,967 pounds of frozen and 589,486 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 1.18% from last year and 16.85% from last month, while fresh stocks show increases of 204.85% over last year and 84.76% over last month.


Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 508,187 pounds; chickens 3,872,261 pounds; fowl 1,276,969 pounds; ducks 121,228 pounds; geese 83,178 pounds; turkeys 1,137,225 pounds; unclassified 596,795 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of .04% and 4.42% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 15,316,064 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,343,083 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of .47% over last year and a decrease of 12.60% from last month; and other fish in cold storage shows increases of 63.99% over last year and 30.14% over last month.

During the month of January 3,124,746 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,522,409 pounds frozen during the month of December.
