COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, MARCH 1, 1928

The butter in storage amounts to 12,419,050 pounds of creamery and 162,000 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 89.52% over last year and a decrease of 33.99% from last month, while dairy butter shows decreases of 56.54% from last year and 17.06% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 15,569,794 pounds showing decreases of 3.83% and 10.32% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 275,980 dozen showing an increase of 146.42% over last year and a decrease of 72.68% from last month. Eggs, other than cold storage show 274,388 dozen, having decreased 25.20% from last year and 14.65% from last month; while frozen eggs, totalling 901,373 pounds, also show decreases of 17.99% from last year and 13.33% from last month.

Pork stocks are as follows: fresh frozen 22,408,206 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,945,354 pounds; cured, dry salted, 1,391,693 pounds; cured, sweet pickled, 9,994,216 pounds; in process of cure, 8,807,873 pounds. Comparative figures show increases in fresh frozen pork of 8.76% over last year and 40.48% over last month; while fresh, not frozen stocks show an increase of 9.23% over last year and a decrease of 45.07% from last month. Cured, dry salted pork shows a decrease of 4.11% from last year and an increase of 9.31% over last month; while cured, sweet pickled shows increases of 47.44% over last year and 2.80% over last month. Stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 14.43% from last year and an increase of 18.67% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,861,403 pounds, showing a decrease of 14.12% from last year and an increase of 28.25% over last month.

Beef stocks in storage amount to 11,533,418 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,373,890 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 120,839 pounds of cured beef and 288,655 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 32.55% from last year and 16.95% from last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen also show decreases of 2.81% and 21.64% from last year and last month respectively. Cured stocks show decreases of 61.03% from last year and 46.05% from last month and stocks, in process of cure show a decrease of 24.36% from last year and an increase of 18.96% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 589,481 pounds of fresh frozen and 286,873 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Decreases are shown in fresh frozen stocks of 45.51% from last year and 33.31% from last month; while fresh, not frozen stocks show increases of 35.76% over last year and 1.86% over last month.

Mutton & Lamb stocks total 4,098,948 pounds of frozen and 93,041 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 2.56% from last year and 17.34% from last month; and stocks not frozen also show decreases of 23.81% and 84.22% from last year and last month respectively.

Stocks of poultry are as follows: broilers 378,252 pounds; chickens 3,829,722 pounds; fowl 1,149,409 pounds; ducks 105,193 pounds; geese 37,997 pounds; turkeys 1,315,771 pounds; unclassified 473,989 pounds. Total poultry shows an increase of 4.03% over last year and a decrease of 6.33% from last month.

Fish stocks total 14,336,152 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,114,464 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows an increase of 2.04% over last year and a decrease of 8.69% from last month; and other fish in cold storage also shows an increase of 40.44% over last year and a decrease of 34.21% from last month.

During the month of February 1,819,122 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 3,124,746 pounds frozen during the month of January.


