COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, APRIL 1st, 1928.

The butter in storage amounts to 6,707,767 pounds of creamery and 124,633 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows an increase of 283.97% over last year and a decrease of 46.01% from last month, while dairy butter shows decreases of 41.23% from last year and 23.13% from last month.

Cheese stocks total 13,134,052 pounds showing an increase of 1.94% over last year and a decrease of 15.64% from last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 330,608 dozen showing a decrease of 43.49% from last year and an increase of 19.79% over last month. Eggs, other than cold storage show 346,426 dozen also showing a decrease of 41.74% from last year and an increase of 23.52% over last month; while frozen eggs totalling 763,923 pounds show decreases of 10.42% and 20.57% from last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 25,668,190 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,855,552 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,408,051 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 13,214,834 pounds; in process of cure 7,505,214 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen pork to have increased 15.22% over last year and 12.53% over last month; and fresh stocks, not frozen show an increase of 25.72% over last year and a decrease of 2.28% from last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show increases of 72.94% over last year and 144.89% over last month; and cured, sweet pickled stocks also show increases of 62.03% over last year and 32.22% over last month. Stocks, in process of cure show decreases of 31.54% from last year and 14.79% from last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,705,484 pounds, showing decreases of 17.94% and 4.04% from last year and last month respectively.

Beef stocks in storage amount to 8,597,315 pounds of fresh frozen; 5,084,879 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 106,934 pounds of cured; and 198,411 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 39.65% from last year and 25.97% from last month; while stocks not frozen show increases of 34.69% over last year and 16.26% over last month. Cured stocks show decreases of 67.07% from last year and 11.51% from last month; while stocks, in process of cure also show decreases of 38.59% and 31.27% from last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 366,326 pounds of fresh frozen and 335,356 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show decreases of 52.16% from last year and 40.69% from last month; while fresh, not frozen stocks show increases of 46.02% over last year and 34.33% over last month.

Mutton and Lamb stocks total 3,335,758 pounds of frozen and 138,562 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 1.33% from last year and 20.02% from last month; while not frozen stocks show increases of 49.59% over last year and 48.93% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 352,355 pounds; chickens 2,990,797 pounds; fowl 1,022,683 pounds; ducks 37,869 pounds; geese 44,931 pounds; turkeys 1,131,736 pounds; unclassified 368,639 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 7.37% and 18.65% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 12,722,083 pounds of fresh frozen and 4,274,473 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows decreases of 2.66% from last year and 14.20% from last month, while other fish in cold storage shows increases of 9.90% over last year and 2.92% over last month.


During the month of March 3,064,874 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 1,819,122 pounds frozen during the month of February.
