COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JUNE 1st, 1928

The butter in storage amounts to 3,304,128 pounds of creamery and 70,626 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows decreases of 17.37% from last year and 9.63% from last month and dairy butter shows a decrease of 49.20% from last year and an increase of 58.94% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 9,074,687 pounds showing decreases of 19.07% and 17.44% from last year and last month respectively.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 10,436,223 dozen; eggs, other than cold storage 602,526 dozen; and frozen eggs 2,159,795 pounds. Cold storage eggs show a decrease of 3.25% from last year and an increase of 154.79% over last month; other than cold storage eggs show decreases of 2.81% from last year and 13.52% from last month; while frozen eggs show increases of 52.98% and 160.75% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 26,402,269 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,140,452 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,913,229 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 11,789,386 pounds; in process of cure 6,428,638 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 21.88% over last year and decreased 7.31% from last month; while fresh stocks, not frozen have also increased 19.44% over last year and decreased 2.57% from last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show increases of 52.46% over last year and 5.25% over last month; and cured, sweet pickled stocks also show increases of 48.93% over last year and 4.85% over last month. Stocks in process of cure show decreases of 46.14% and 8.76% from last year and last month respectively.

The lard in storage amounts to 3,867,838 pounds showing a decrease of 32.99% from last year and an increase of 5.09% over last month.

Beef stocks in storage amount to 3,813,348 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,650,270 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 147,934 pounds of cured; and 118,965 pounds of beef, in process of cure. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have decreased 48.20% from last year and 36.09% from last month; and fresh stocks, not frozen have increased 11.09% over last year and decreased 2.70% from last month. Cured stocks show a decrease of 63.21% from last year and an increase of 36.88% over last month; while stocks in process of cure show decreases of 48.84% and 21.01% from last year and last month respectively.

Veal in storage amounts to 497,699 pounds of fresh frozen, showing a decrease of 36.89% from last year and an increase of 7.54% over last month; and 584,050 pounds of fresh, not frozen stocks showing increases of 74.85% and 7.39% over last year and last month respectively.

Mutton & Lamb stocks total 1,014,568 pounds of frozen and 110,301 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 35.38% from last year and 48.39% from last month; while stocks, not frozen show a decrease of 53.49% from last year and an increase of 23.90% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers, 204,446 pounds; chickens, 1,762,073 pounds; fowl, 387,320 pounds; ducks, 60,509 pounds; geese, 35,402 pounds; turkeys 750,508 pounds; unclassified 346,183 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 21.46% from last year and 25.31% from last month.

Fish stocks total 11,716,526 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,257,011 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish show decreases of 6.14% from last year and 6.01% from last month; while other fish in cold storage show increases of 43.55% and 6.20% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of May 2,157,382 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,269,752 pounds frozen during the month of April.


