COLD STORAGE HOLDINGS, JULY 1st, 1928

The butter in storage amounts to 11,931,802 pounds of creamery and 284,012 pounds of dairy. Creamery butter shows a decrease of 19.20% from last year and an increase of 262.98% over last month; and dairy butter also shows a decrease of 12.34% from last year and an increase of 302.14% over last month.

Cheese stocks total 16,653,296 pounds showing a decrease of 17.10% from last year and an increase of 83.51% over last month.

Eggs in cold storage amount to 15,189,239 dozen; eggs, other than cold storage 510,964 dozen; and frozen eggs 3,012,981 pounds. Cold storage eggs show increases of 4.96% over last year and 34.66% over last month; other than cold storage eggs show decreases of 37.48% from last year and 16.38% from last month; and frozen eggs show increases of 75.81% and 39.49% over last year and last month respectively.

Pork stocks are as follows:- fresh frozen 24,561,005 pounds; fresh, not frozen 3,007,540 pounds; cured, dry salted 3,239,384 pounds; cured, sweet pickled 11,889,780 pounds; and in process of cure 7,222,258 pounds. Comparative figures show fresh frozen stocks to have increased 29.23% over last year and decreased 8.01% from last month; and stocks, fresh, not frozen also show an increase of 8.36% over last year and a decrease of 4.75% from last month. Cured, dry salted stocks show an increase of .22% over last year and a decrease of 17.33% from last month; cured, sweet pickled show increases of 51.29% and .75% over last year and last month respectively; and stocks in process of cure a decrease of 23.65% from last year and an increase of 10.12% over last month.

The lard in storage amounts to 4,106,379 pounds, showing a decrease of 31.33% from last year and an increase of 4.55% over last month.

Beef stocks in storage amount to 3,120,311 pounds of fresh frozen; 4,612,492 pounds of fresh, not frozen; 151,528 pounds of cured; and 213,095 pounds of stocks in process of cure. Comparative figures show decreases in fresh frozen beef of 36.06% from last year and 19.05% from last month; and in fresh stocks, not frozen, an increase of 18.91% over last year and a decrease of 1.34% from last month. Cured stocks show decreases of 54.99% from last year and .27% from last month and stocks in process of cure show a decrease of 19.42% from last year and an increase of 79.12% over last month.

Veal in storage amounts to 630,262 pounds of fresh frozen and 468,683 pounds of fresh, not frozen. Fresh frozen stocks show a decrease of 24.63% from last year and an increase of 24.31% over last month, while fresh stocks, not frozen show an increase of 47.92% over last year and a decrease of 21.10% from last month.

Mutton and lamb stocks total 533,010 pounds of frozen and 217,929 pounds of not frozen. Frozen stocks show decreases of 28.70% from last year and 47.69% from last month; while not frozen show increases of 15.81% over last year and 94.06% over last month.

Stocks of poultry are as follows:- broilers 164,308 pounds; chickens 1,177,906 pounds; fowl 288,536 pounds; ducks 88,863 pounds; geese 33,596 pounds; turkeys 693,409 pounds; unclassified 350,952 pounds. Total poultry shows decreases of 28.81% and 23.62% from last year and last month respectively.

Fish stocks total 16,463,237 pounds of fresh frozen and 5,863,923 pounds of other fish in cold storage. Fresh frozen fish shows a decrease of .75% from last year and an increase of 35.24% over last month; and other fish in cold storage shows increases of 66.10% and 11.48% over last year and last month respectively.

During the month of June 3,959,358 pounds of fish were frozen as compared with 2,157,382 pounds frozen during the month of May.

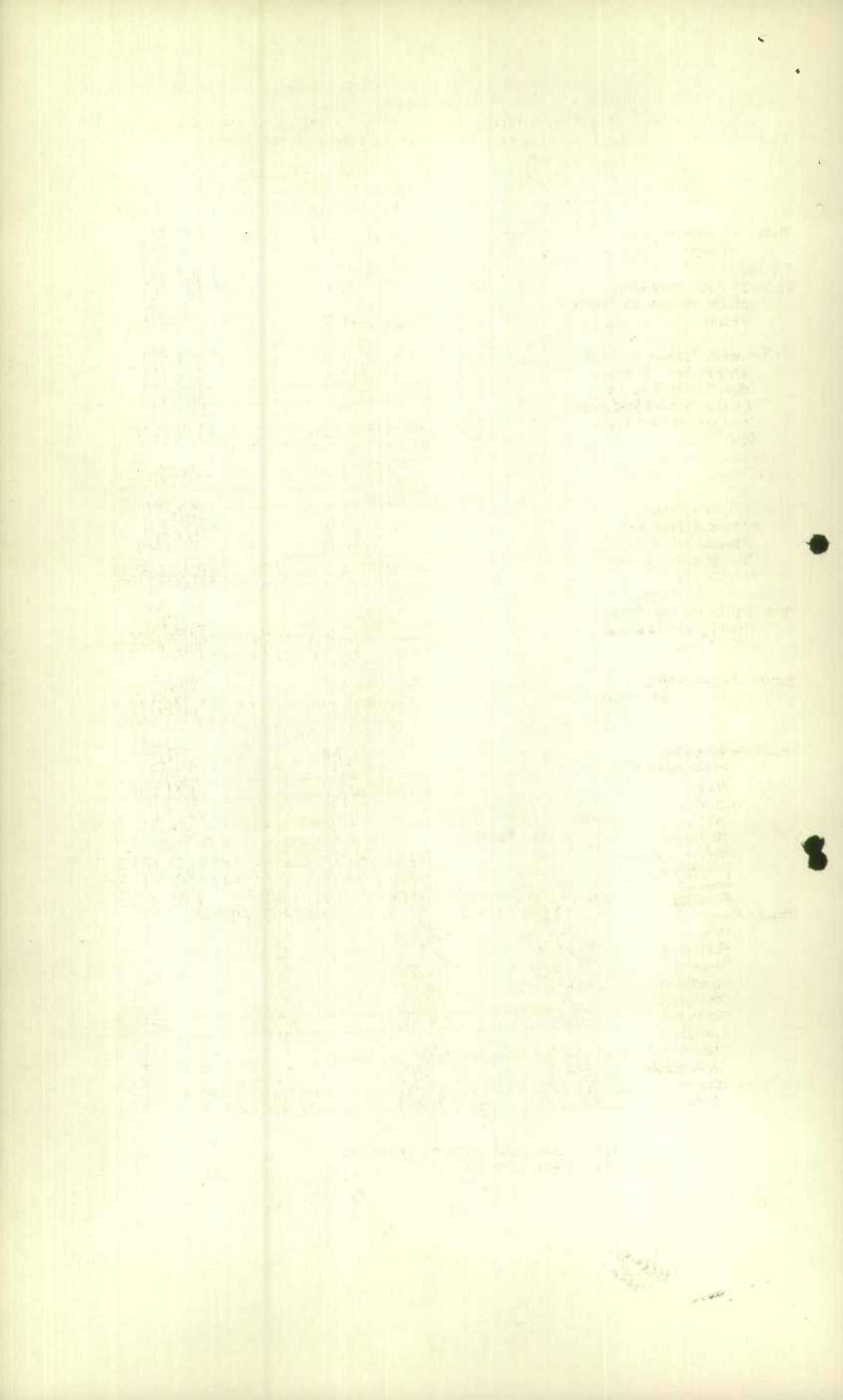
